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Respondents Details:

1. Fulfillment of My (students) Learning Needs:

From the total 184 student respondents, maximum (80.43%) respondents rated as excellent to the fulfillment of their learning needs by curriculum, followed by 16.85%, 2.17%, and 0.54 % of respondents rated it as good, average, and below average respectively.

2. Application of the Curriculum to the Real Life Situation:

It is found that the highest (82.07%) number of student's respondent opined that the applicability of the curriculum to the real life situation is excellent, 14.13% opined it as good, 3.26% replied as it is average and 0.54% says as below average.

3. Clarity about the Course Objectives:

The majority (83.15%) respondents from the total 184 students opined that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found excellent; followed by 12.50% remarked as good, 3.91% think it is as average whereas 1.09% opined in this respect as below average.

4. Weightage Given to Employability:

From the total 184 respondents, maximum (84.24%) of student respondents says that the Weightage given to employability in curriculum found excellent, 9.78% remarked as it is good, 4.89% replied as average and remaining students (1.09%) are opined as it is below average.

5. Weightage Given to Skill Development:


It is found that the highest (86.96%) number of respondents opined that the Weightage given to skill development in curriculum is excellent, followed by 8.70% think in this case as good, 3.26% opined as average and only 1.09% remarked as it is as below average.

6. Structure of the Syllabus:

The collected information indicate that the maximum (84.24%) number of respondents found the structure of the syllabus in curriculum is excellent, followed by 10.33% says it is good, 4.35% opined as it is average whereas only 1.09 think it is below average.

7. Difficulty Level of the Course Contents:

From the total 184 student respondents, the maximum (83.15%) number of respondents rated as the difficulty level in the course contents in curriculum taught is found excellent. 9.24%, 6.52%, 1.09% rated to difficulty level of course content in curriculum is as good, average and below average respectively.


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8. Promotion of independent Thinking by Curriculum:

It is remarkable that Maximum (84.78%) of the students from the respondent feel that promotion of independent thinking through curriculum taught is excellent, followed by 10.87% of them opined as good, 3.80% observed it is average and 2.17% rated below average in this respect.

9. Exposure to New Knowledge and Practices:

From the total 184 student's respondents, majority (84.78%) of the respondents think that the exposure to new knowledge and practices in curriculum taught is found excellent, followed by 9.24% rated as good, 3.80% observed as average and 2.17% says below average in this respect.

10. Weightage to Practical or field work:


According to collected responses it is observed that the highest (86.96%) respondents think that Weightage to practical and field work in curriculum is found excellent. The 7.07% respondents remarked in this respect as good, 4.35% says Weightage given to practical or field work in curriculum is average and 1.63 says it is below average.

11. Creation of Interest to Pursue Higher Education:

From the total 184 respondents maximum (86.41%) respondents opined that the creation of interest to pursue higher education from curriculum is excellent, 10.33% respondents think that it is good and equal number (1.63%) of respondents says average and below average.

12. Overall rating:

It is noted that maximum (82.61%) students respondent rated to curriculum found excellent, 12.50% think it is good, 3.26% rated it as average and very few (1.63%) given overall rating to the curriculum as below average.


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

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Respondents Details:

1. Applicability of the syllabus to Local Developmental Needs:

The 48 teacher respondents had given their responses on applicability of the syllabus to local developmental needs. Maximum (68.75%) of the respondents rated as excellent, followed 20.83, 8.33 % and 2.08 % of respondents says average, and excellent and below average respectively.

2. Difficulty Level of the Syllabus:

It is found that the majority (50.00%) of teacher respondent opined that the difficulty level of the syllabus in curriculum is found good, followed by 35.42% think it is as average, 4.17% replied as it is excellent and 10.42% replied as below average.

3. Clarity about the Course Objectives:

The maximum (50.00%) respondents from the total teacher opined that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found good; followed by 33.33% remarked as excellent, 10.42% opined it is as average and 6.25% remarked as the below average.

4. Weightage given to Employability:

The fourth aspect of this survey concerned with Weightage given to employability. From the total 48 teacher respondents, maximum teachers (47.92%) says that the Weightage given to employability in curriculum is good, 31.25% observed it is average, 18.75% rated it is as excellent and remaining teachers (2.08%) are remarked as it is below average.

5. Depth of the Course Content:


As far as depth of the course contents in curriculum is concerned maximum (66.67%) number of respondents opined that they found it is good, followed by 18.75% think it is as average, 14.58% remarked it as excellent and No responses obtain to below average option about depth of the course content in curriculum.

6. Incorporation of the Latest Knowledge & Information:

It is observed that the maximum (56.25%) teachers remarked that the incorporation of the latest knowledge & information in curriculum is good, followed by 27.08% says it is average, 16.67% rated as it is excellent whereas response not received to below average.

7. Research Possibilities:

From the total 48 teacher respondents, majority (47.92%) rated as the research possibilities in curriculum taught is found good, 27.08% replied as average and 20.83% rated to research possibilities in curriculum as excellent and 4.17% think it is below average.


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8. Mechanism Used for Development/Revision of Curriculum by BoS:

The Maximum (58.33%) of the teacher respondents says mechanism used for development / revision of curriculum is found good, followed by 33.33% opined as it is average, 2.08% think as excellent and 6.25% of them opined average and below average.

9. Weightage Given to Learning Values Like knowledge, skills, analytical abilities, etc.:

On the feedback of Weightage given to learning values like knowledge, skills, analytical abilities etc. in the curriculum, from the total 48 teacher respondents, maximum (72.92 %) respondents opined that the Weightage given to learning values like knowledge, skills as well as analytical abilities in curriculum is good, followed by 14.58% says it excellent, 8.33% replied as average and 4.17% remarked as it is below average.

10. Relevance of Course Outcomes:


On the basis of obtain responses, it is noted that 68.75% opined that the relevance of course outcomes in the curriculum is good, 16.67% respondents replied as the relevance of course outcomes in curriculum is average, 12.50 think it is excellent and 2.08% opined it is as below average.

1. Weightage Given to Employability / Skill Development:

Total 09 employer respondents marked their responses on Weightage given to employability / skill development. It is observed that majority (55.55%) respondents opined as excellent in this regard and 44.45% respondents replied as good. No responses found in favor of average and below average option of the given question.

2. Fulfillment of Demands of at Our Workplace:

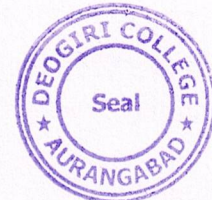
6. Communication/Presentation Skill Development:

Respondent's details:

1. Fulfillment of Learning Needs:

From the total 110 alumni respondents, 45.45% of the respondents rated fulfillment of learning needs from curriculum as excellent, followed by 49.09%, 4.55%, and 0.91% of respondents rated as good, average, and below average respectively.

2. Application of the Curriculum to the Real Life:

It is observed that the Maximum 62.73% of alumni respondents think that the applicability of the curriculum to the real life is excellent, followed by 31.82% opined it is as good, 5.45% remarked as average and responses not received in favor of below average.

3. Clarity about the course Objectives:

On this issue the total 110 alumni had given their responses. The greater number of respondent (55.45%) remarked that the clarity in course objectives found excellent, 42.73% replied in this respect as it is good, 1.82% rated it is as average whereas no response obtain to below average option.

4. Weightage given to Employability :

From the total 110 alumni respondents, the maximum (57.27%) alumni remarked that the Weightage given to the employability in curriculum is excellent, followed by 21.82%, 17.27% and 3.64% alumni remarked as good, average and below average respectively.

5. Weightage given to skill development:

It is observed that 64.55% of respondents think that the Weightage given to the skill development in curriculum found excellent, 21.82% rated as good, 10.00% think it is as average and remaining (3.64%) alumni are opined as below average in respect of curriculum.

6. Weightage given to entrepreneurship: As far as Weightage given to entrepreneurship is concerned, it is observed that the majority (51.82%) number of respondents replied that the Weightage given to the entrepreneurship in curriculum is found good, 24.55% opined in this case as excellent, 22.73 remarked as average and only 0.91% think it is as below average.

7. Difficulty level of the course content:

It is noted that the maximum (58.18%) respondents think that the difficulty level of the course content is excellent in curriculum taught, followed by 35.45% remarked as good, 6.36% opined as average and responses not received to below average response.

8. Promotion of Independent thinking by curriculum:

From the total 110 alumni respondents, The highest (49.09%) respondents replied as the promotion of independent thinking by curriculum taught is excellent, followed by 26.36% think good, 24.55% remarked as average and response not received to below average option.

9. Usefulness of the curriculum at workplace:

From the 110 alumni, maximum (49.09%) of the alumni expressed that curriculum taught are useful to them at their workplace as they says good. 41.82% of them opined as excellent, 8.18% remarked as average whereas only 0.91% marked their responses as below average in this case.

10. Usefulness of curriculum in my higher education:

From the total 110 respondents, majority (55.45%) of the alumni expressed that curriculum taught are useful for their higher education as they replied as excellent in this respect, followed by 36.36% opined as good, 6.36% remarked as average and 1.82 says below average about usefulness of curriculum in their higher education.

11. Fulfillment of Objectives:


It is highlighted that the greater number of respondents (71.82%) replied on fulfillment of objectives from curriculum found good, 23.64% opined as excellent, 1.82% think as average and 2.73% says it is below average.

12. Overall rating:


The final question in feedback is about overall rating regarding the curriculum. From the total 110 respondents majority (82.73%) rated to curriculum as good, 17.27% replied as good, responses not received to average and below average option.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT
2017 -2018

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Deogiri College, Aurangabad collected feedback on curriculum from the stakeholders like students, parents, alumni, employers and teachers at the end of the academic year 2017-2018. The feedback was further analyzed and following actions were taken thereafter:

- The feedback on curriculum by students was positive hence the efforts of the teachers were appreciated.
- Feedback by employers and teachers suggest for certain changes in the curriculum.
- Teachers were encouraged to collect feedback on the curriculum from external peer and convey the same to the affiliating university.
- The issues wherein the parents and alumni exhibited their concerns were decided to be addressed through short term certificate courses and co-curricular activities.
- The plan for introduction of PG program in Music was finalized.
- Besides it, the departments like Drama, Biotechnology and Chemistry were encouraged to commence B.Voc programs for skill education.
- Community College was to be proposed by Department of Chemistry.

- Certain departments were advised to start a course in research methodology at PG level.
- HoDs were advised to go through the feedback analysis communicate suggestions to the concerned BoS at the affiliating university.
