## 1. Knowledge base of the teacher:

Out of 290 respondents, $88.97 \%$ of students feel that the knowledge base of the teacher is 'excellent'. $8.28 \%$ recorded this parameter on 'good' scale, $1.72 \%$ of the students feel that knowledge base of the teacher is 'average' and 'below average' is recorded by $1.03 \%$ students.

## 2. Communication skill of the teacher

It is clear from figure no. 2 that $86.55 \%$ of students feel that the teachers have an excellent skill in communication in and off the classroom, whereas $10 \%$ students have noted on 'good' scale. $2.41 \%$ students recorded their responses on this parameter on 'average' scale and only $1.03 \%$ students feel that Communication skill of the teacher is 'below average'.

## 3. Sincerity/Commitment of the teacher

The third parameter is about commitment of the teacher. $89.66 \%$ students observed that teachers are very much committed to the job in all respects. $7.24 \%$ responses are recorded on 'good' scale. $1.38 \%$ students registered their responses on 'average' scale and 'below average' are found from $1.72 \%$ of students.

Figure no. 4 illustrates that $89.31 \%$ students feel that teachers have an excellent skill in generating interest in learning process. $6.90 \%$ students noted their responses on 'good' scale whereas $2.07 \%$ students said that this skill in the teacher is 'average'. Only $1.72 \%$ students responded to this question on 'below average' scale.

## 5. Ability to integrate course material with environment/other issues, to provide a broader perspective

Figure no. 5 states that $87.24 \%$ of students feel that the teachers have an 'excellent' ability to the question asked, whereas $8.62 \%$ students have noted on 'good' scale. $3.45 \%$ students recorded their responses to this parameter on 'average' scale and $0.69 \%$ students feel that ability of the teacher is 'below average'.

Out of 4798 respondents, $88.10 \%$ of students feel that the knowledge base of the teacher is 'excellent'. $9.98 \%$ recorded this parameter on 'good' scale, $1.31 \%$ of the students feel that knowledge base of the teacher is 'average' and 'below average' is recorded by $0.60 \%$ students.

## 2. Communication skill of the teacher

It is clear from figure no. 2 that $83.83 \%$ of students feel that the teachers have an excellent skill in communication in and off the classroom, whereas $10.42 \%$ students have noted on 'good' scale. $2.02 \%$ students recorded their responses on this parameter on 'average' scale and only $0.73 \%$ students feel that Communication skill of the teacher is 'below average'.

It is clear from figure no. 2 that $84 \%$ of students feel that the teachers have an excellent skill in communication in and off the classroom, whereas $11.21 \%$ students have noted on 'good' scale. $3.47 \%$ students recorded their responses on this parameter on 'average' scale and only $1.32 \%$ students feel that Communication skill of the teacher is 'below average'.

## Analysis:

## 1. Knowledge base of the teacher:

Responses from 2361students were collected out of which $85.35 \%$ of students feel that the knowledge base of the teacher is 'excellent'. $13.09 \%$ recorded this parameter on 'good' scale, $1.19 \%$ of the students feel that knowledge base of the teacher is 'average' and 'below average' is recorded by $0.38 \%$ students.

## 2. Communication skill of the teacher

Figure no. 2 indicates that $82.68 \%$ of students feel that the teachers have an excellent skill in communication in and off the classroom, whereas $13.98 \%$ students have noted on 'good' scale. $2.75 \%$ students recorded their responses on this parameter on 'average' scale and only $0.59 \%$ students feel that Communication skill of the teacher is 'below average'.

## 3. Sincerity/Commitment of the teacher

The third parameter is about commitment of the teacher. $84.88 \%$ students observed that teachers are very much committed to the job in all respects. $12.28 \%$ responses are recorded on 'good' scale. $2.50 \%$ students registered their responses on 'average' scale and 'below average' responses are found from $0.34 \%$ of students.

## 4. Interest generated by the teacher

Figure no. 4 illustrates that $83.65 \%$ students feel that teachers have an excellent skill in generating interest in learning process. $12.11 \%$ students noted their responses on 'good' scale whereas $3.39 \%$ students said that this skill in the teacher is 'average'. Only $0.85 \%$ students responded to this question on 'below average' scale.

## 5. Ability to integrate course material with environment/other issues, to provide a broader perspective

Figure no. 5 states that $83.78 \%$ of students feel that the teachers have an 'excellent' ability to the question asked, whereas $12.41 \%$ students have noted on 'good' scale. $3.22 \%$ students recorded their responses to this parameter on 'average' scale and $0.59 \%$ students feel that ability of the teacher is 'below average'.

## 6. Ability to integrate content with other courses

Out of 6983 respondents, $83.23 \%$ of students feel that the teachers have an 'excellent' ability to integrate content with other courses. $12.75 \%$ students recorded this parameter on 'good' scale, $3.26 \%$ of the students feel that teacher's ability to integrate content with other courses is 'average' and 'below average' is recorded by $0.76 \%$ students.

## 7. Accessibility of the teacher in and out of the class

From figure no. 7, it is clear that $85.35 \%$ of students feel that the teachers are available for students in and out of the class conveniently, whereas $10.76 \%$ students have
noted on 'good' scale. $3.22 \%$ students recorded their responses to this parameter on 'average' scale and only $0.68 \%$ students feel that availability of teachers is 'below average'.

## 8. Ability to design Quizzes/Test/Assignments/Examination and other projects to evaluate student understanding of the course

Responses were sought from the students regarding ability of the teacher to design Quizzes/Test/Assignments/Examination and other projects to evaluate student understanding of the course. $85.81 \%$ students feel that teachers have an 'excellent' ability in this concern. $11.22 \%$ students have recorded their responses on 'good' scale. $2.50 \%$ of students feel that teachers have an 'average' skill concerning this parameter and $0.47 \%$ students have responded to this question on 'below average scale'.

## 9. Provision of sufficient time for feedback

This question was related to the time given to the students to register their feedback. $83.86 \%$ students feel that it is 'excellent', $12.37 \%$ students observed it to be 'good'. $3.05 \%$ students said that they got 'average' time for feedback while $0.72 \%$ students noted their responses on 'below average' scale.

## 10. Overall rating

$85.68 \%$ students have noted their responses on 'excellent' scale in overall rating. $11.10 \%$ students registered their responses on 'good' scale. $2.46 \%$ students marked their answers on 'average' scale whereas $0.76 \%$ students observed it to be on 'below average' scale.
