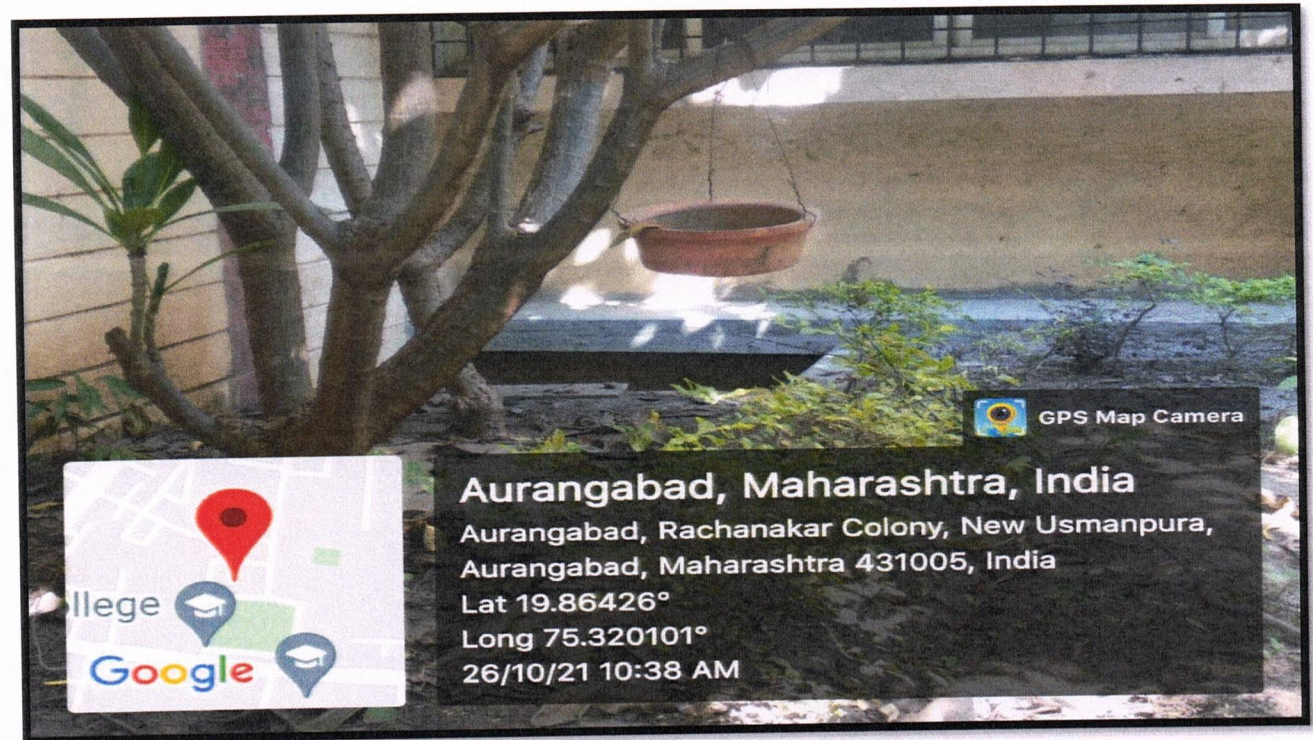
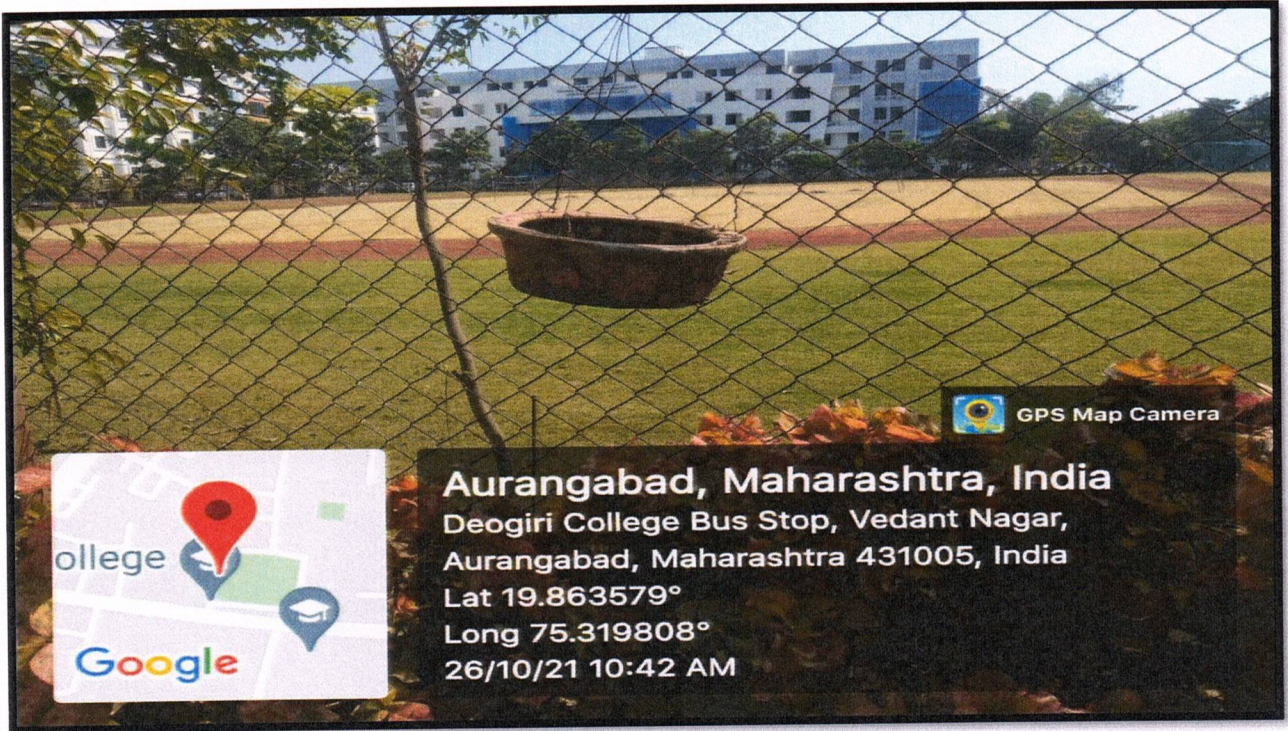


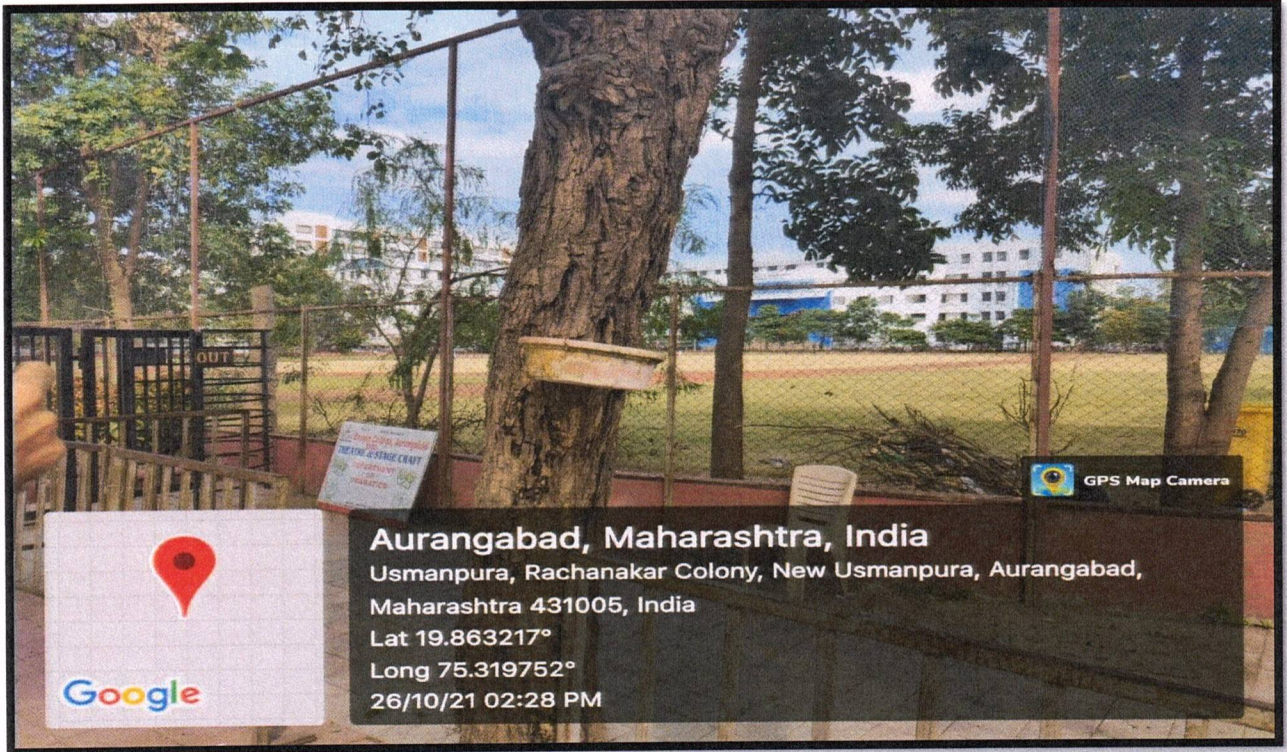




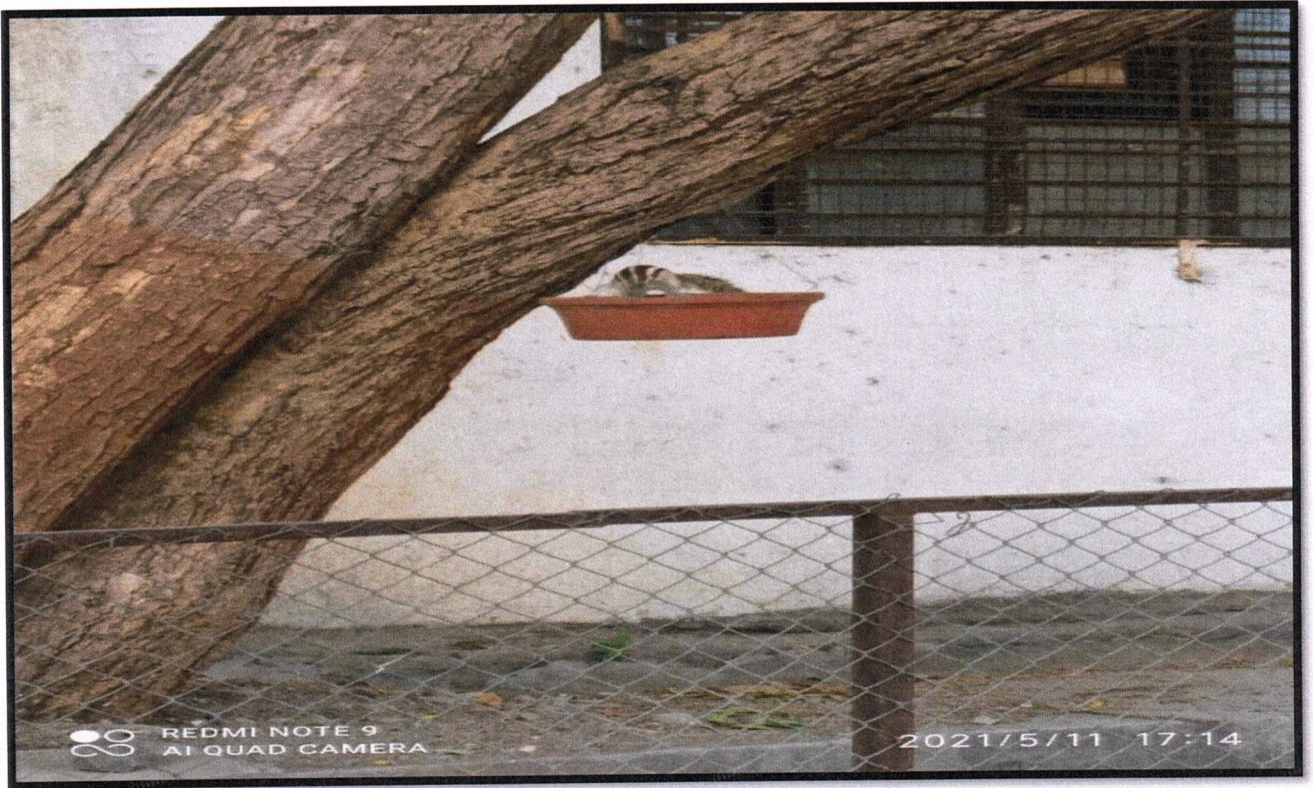








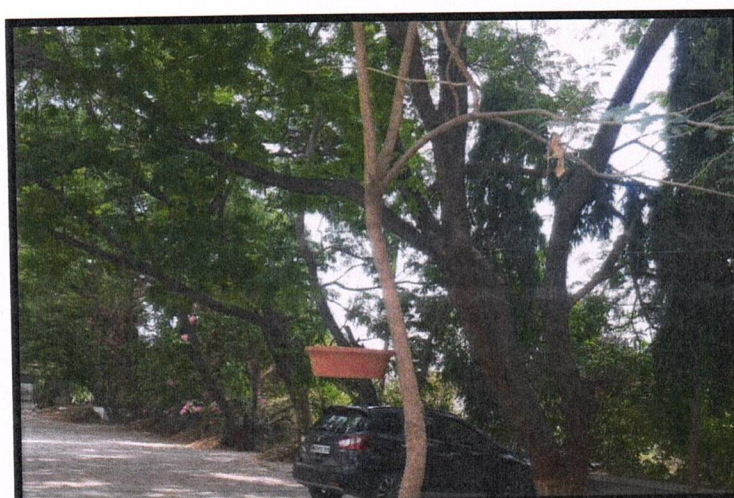




REPORT ON BIRD BATH AND BIRD FEEDERS
