The context:

Due to COVID-19 pandemic outbreak and continuous lockdown all over the country, Deogiri College Aurangabad did not stop teaching and learning process in the college. We started the effective use of ICT based education resources using google suit and zoom platforms. Our college initiated the exhaustive use of information technology in teaching, learning and evaluation process. In addition, our affiliating university- Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University had also adopted the online examination system due to the covid pandemic.

In this context, to understand the student adaptation to the drastic change in the evaluation process, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Deogiri College conducted a survey on the Continuous Online Internal Evaluation - using Google forms. The survey comprised of 7 multiple choice and one descriptive question. The feedback survey was collected from 1551 students and analyzed by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell.

Observations:

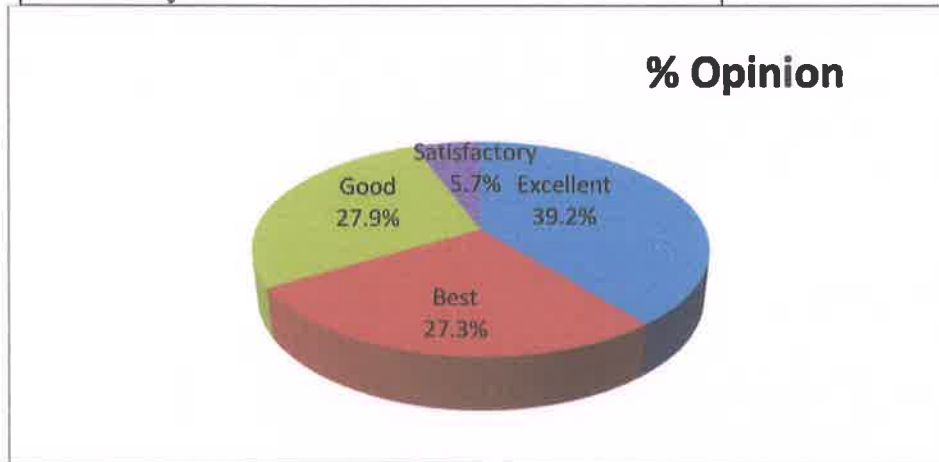
The analysis of feedback survey revealed the following notable observations:

- Students opted the online examination system due to COVID-19 pandemic situation and found it safe.
- The online quizzes / tests arranged by the teachers were rated as excellent by approximately 40% of the students and best by around 25% of the students.
- Around 35% of the teachers have arranged more than 10 quizzes / online tests during the first term of academic year 2020-21.
- Around 75% of the students think that these tests are quite useful to prepare for university examination and hence the number and frequency of such quizzes needs to be increased.
- Around 90% of the students think the quizzes and online tests conducted by the teachers are useful for them for university exams.
- Around 80% students agree with the usefulness of these quizzes for preparation of MPSS / UPSC / NET / SET and other competitive examinations also.
- Around 70% of the students have rated the conducting of these tests as excellent or good.
- 70% of the students think that the number of assignments, seminars and frequency of the quizzes needs be increased.

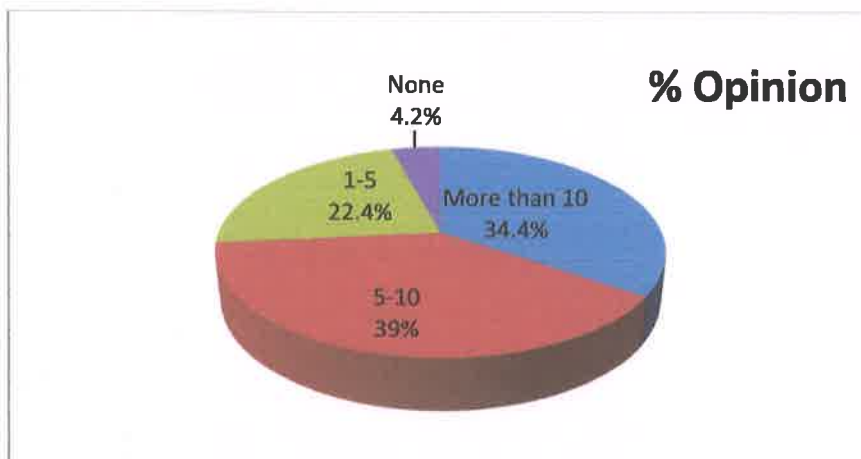

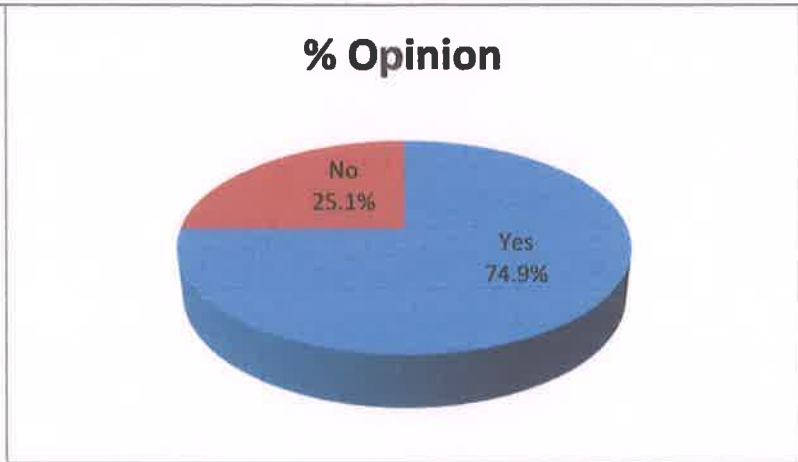
2. How many quizzes/internal tests on an average were organized by your teachers during the last semester?

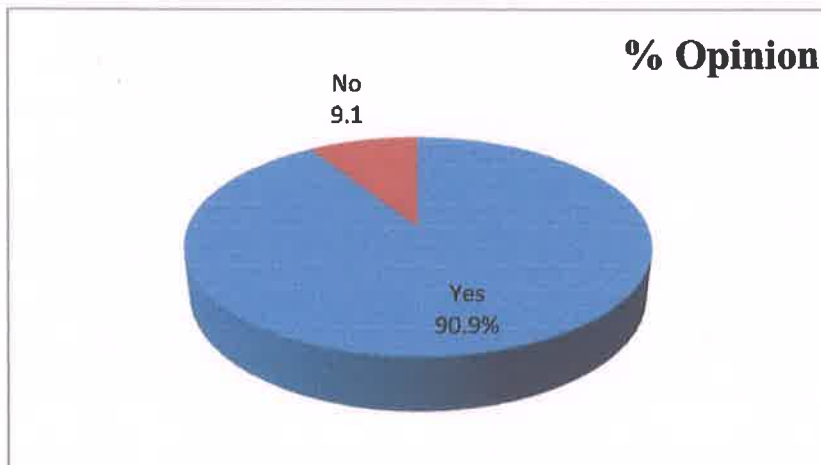
3. Do you think the frequency and number of quizzes/internal tests be increased in the incoming semester?

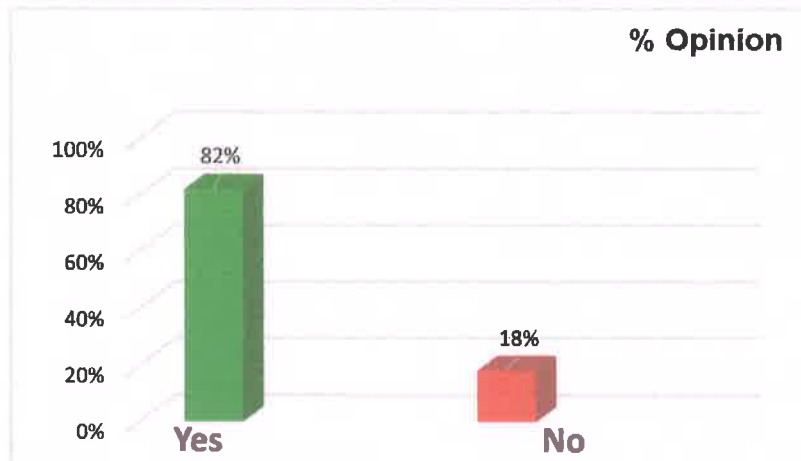

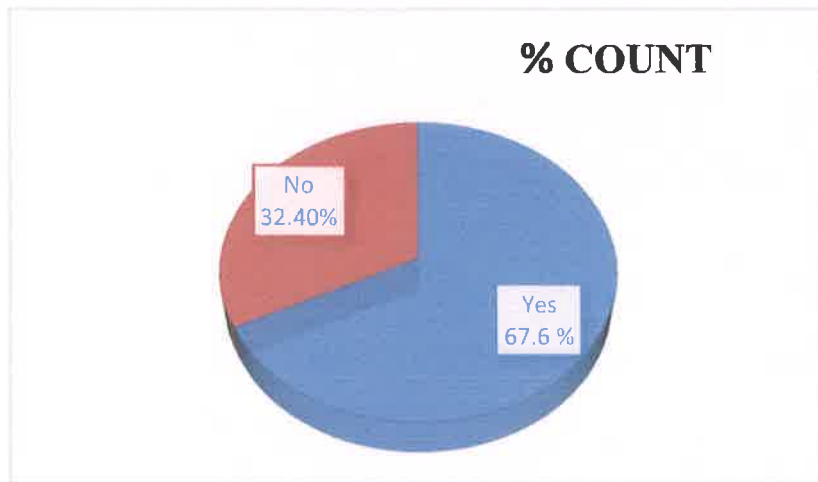

With reference to the above cited subject, I would like to inform you that the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Deogiri College has conducted a survey on regarding the feedback of Online University Exams Oct. / Nov. 2020 held in March/ April 2021.

Almost all the students (98.5%) found the online evaluation process very safe in the COVID-19 pandemic situation. Students were quite satisfied with the examination and evaluation process.

The context:

The examination system of our affiliating university - Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad was switched from offline to online due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation. In order to understand the student mindset, difficulties faced by students and their adaptation to online evaluation system, the **Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Deogiri College Aurangabad** conducted an online survey comprising of eight multiple choice questions and one descriptive question. 1289 students participated in the survey. The survey was conducted and feedback was analyzed.

Observations:

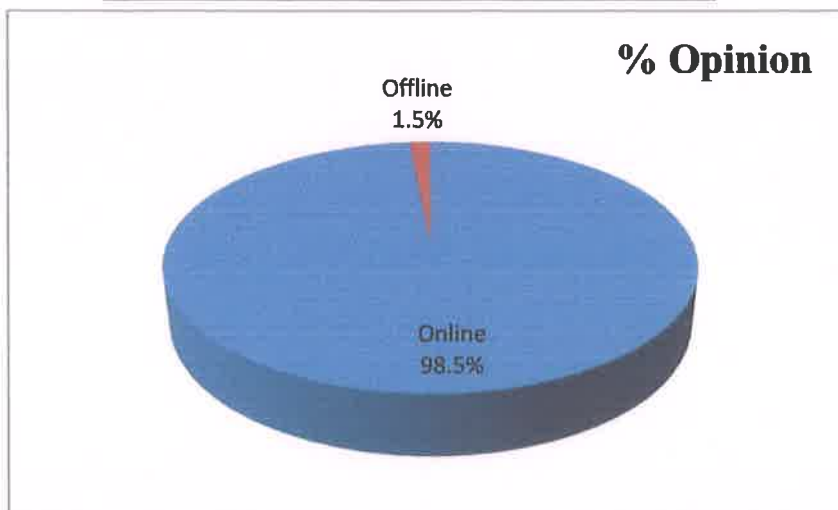
The analysis of the feedback revealed the following notable observations:

- 98.5% adopted the online examination system.
- Around 90% students tried the demo / trail of the online examination before the actual examination.
- Despite of Demo / Trial examination, around 25% faced several technical issues such as server error, error in logging to the online system and students need strengthening of the helpline system in this regard.
- Students opted to adopt the online examination system due to COVID-19 pandemic situation and found it safe.
- The helpline system of the university was highly helpful for the students during the online examination to solve the technical difficulties. Students need a stronger support in this context.
- College teachers has also tried the solve the technical issues faced by the students during the online examinations.
- More technical experts and helpline systems need to be developed to solve the technical issues.

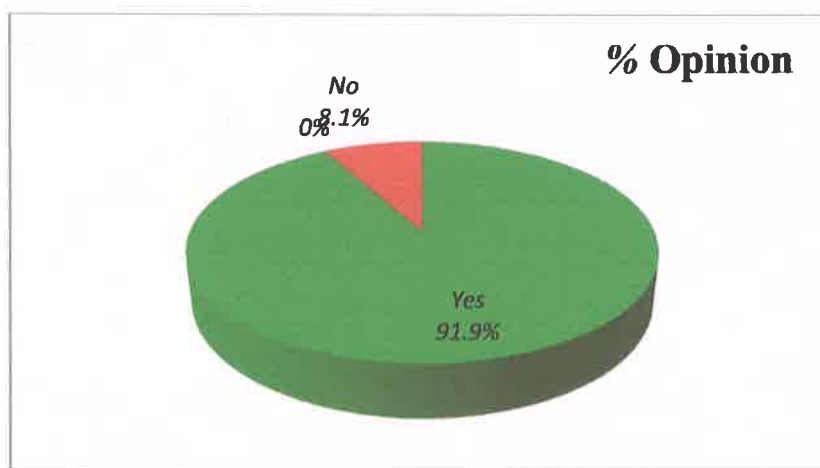
1. Which mode of exam did you opt for writing University exam last semester?

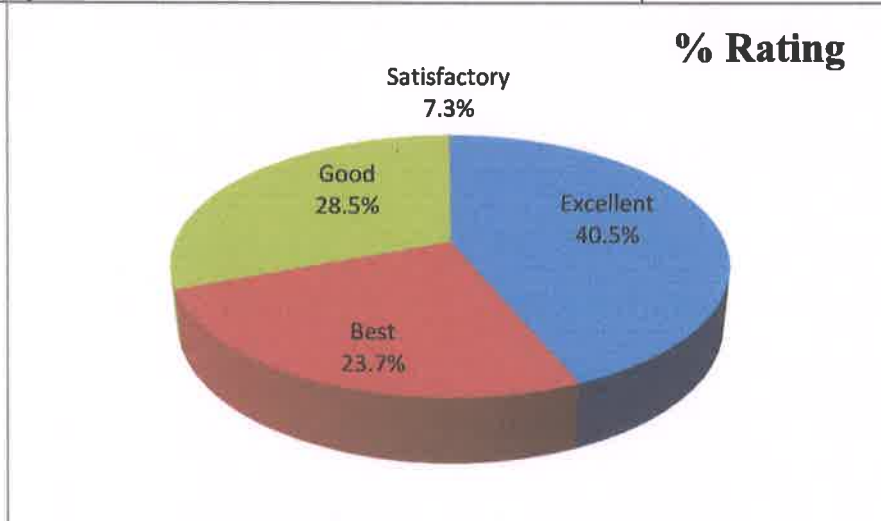

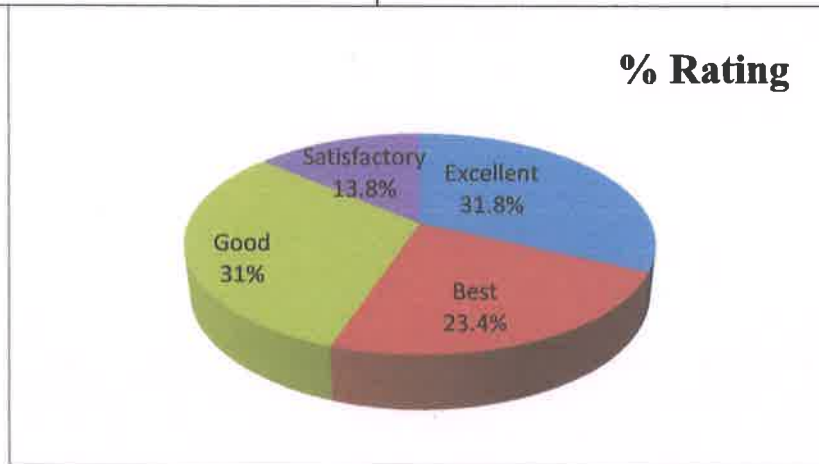

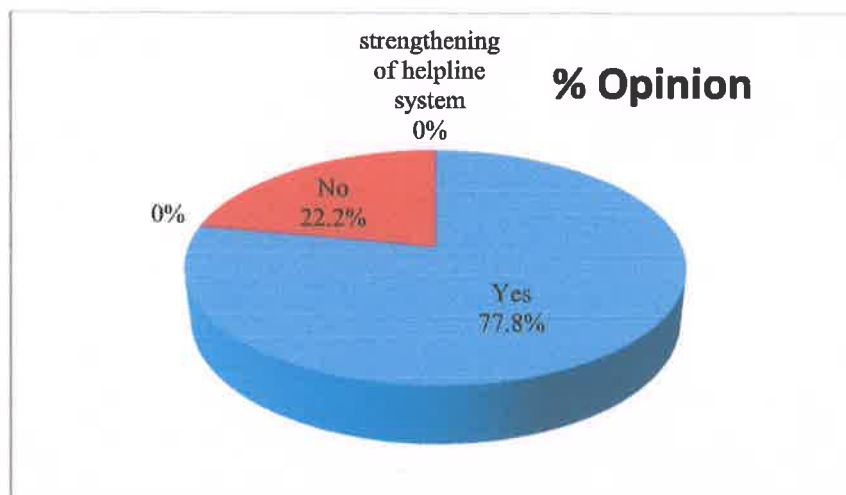

The context:

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Deogiri College, Aurangabad conducted a Survey on the Evaluation Process for the Academic year 2020-21. The survey was conducted to understand the adoptability of the students for the online evaluation process and the extent of their satisfaction. An online survey comprising of 8 objective questions and one descriptive question was circulated among the students and 3,727 responses were collected and analyzed.

Observations:

A critical analysis of the survey revealed the following points:

- Online tests conducted by the teachers using Google forms were highly useful for the students.
- Around 90% of the students were satisfied with their performance in internal tests conducted by the college.
- Around 70% of the respondents preferred to opt the MCQ tests based evaluation process.
- Students agreed the effectiveness of Classical, Online as well as the participative methods including the use of seminars and presentations as the effective methods of teaching.
- Around 90% of the students were satisfied with the current evaluation mechanism of the university.
- Around 92% of the students were satisfied with the 50-50% pattern of evaluation.
- Around 80% of the students were satisfied with their performance in examination in terms of marks obtained.
- Approximately 85% of the students were satisfied with the current redressal mechanism of the university.

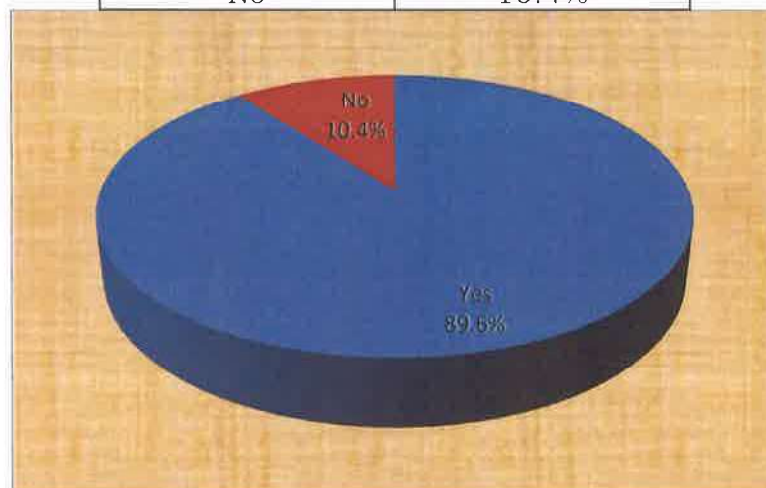
1. Is the online internal tests conducted by your teacher by using Google forms useful to you?

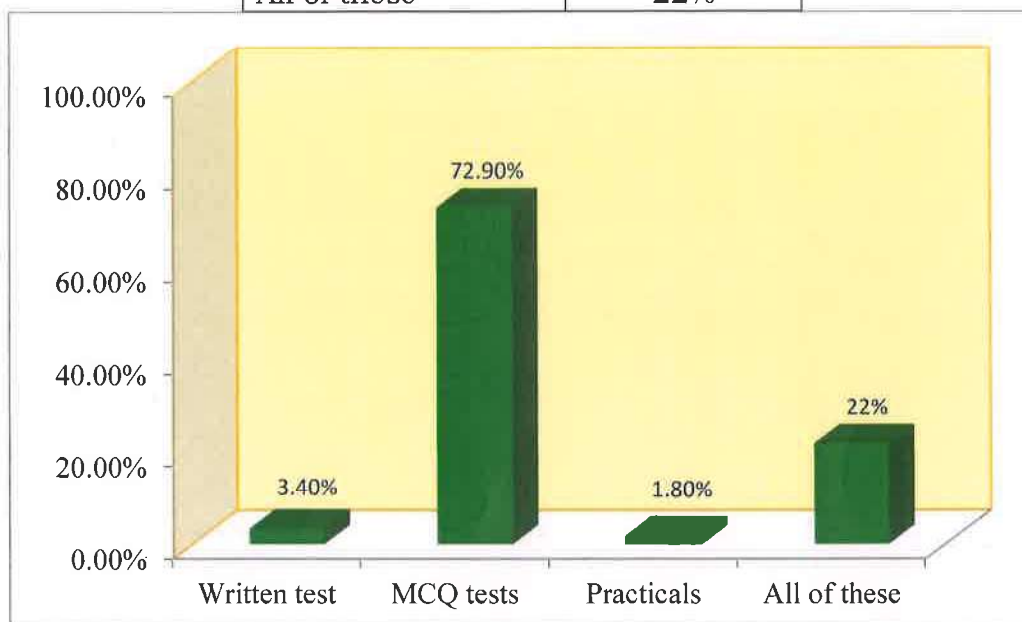
2. Are you satisfied with your performance in the internal tests?

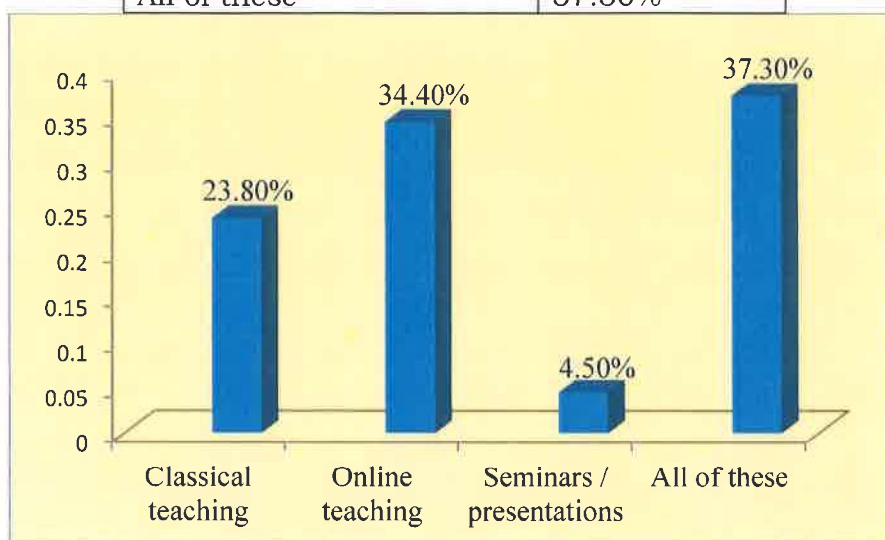

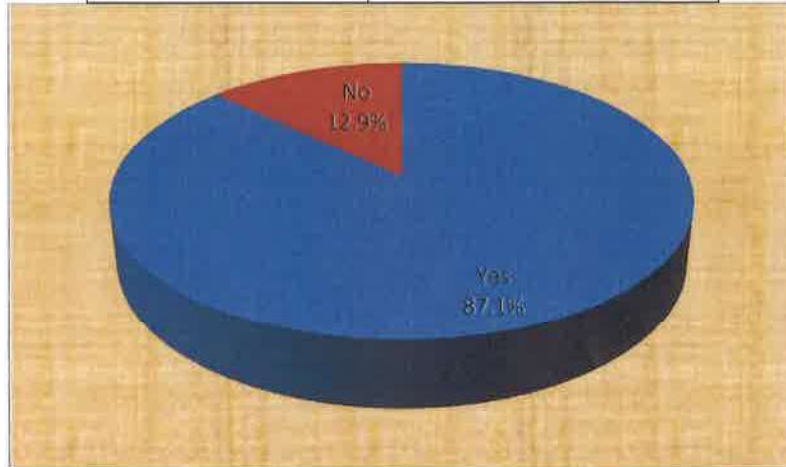
4. Which methods of teaching adopted by your teachers do you think are useful to you?

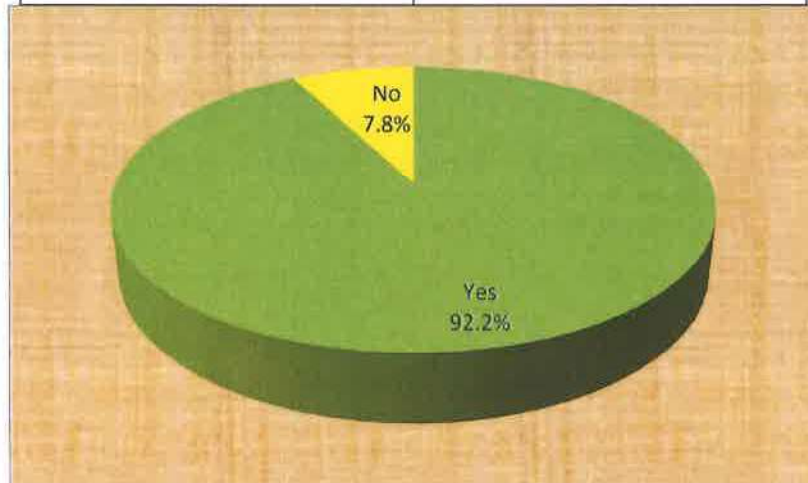
Q.5. Do you think the current university examination pattern evaluates your performance properly?

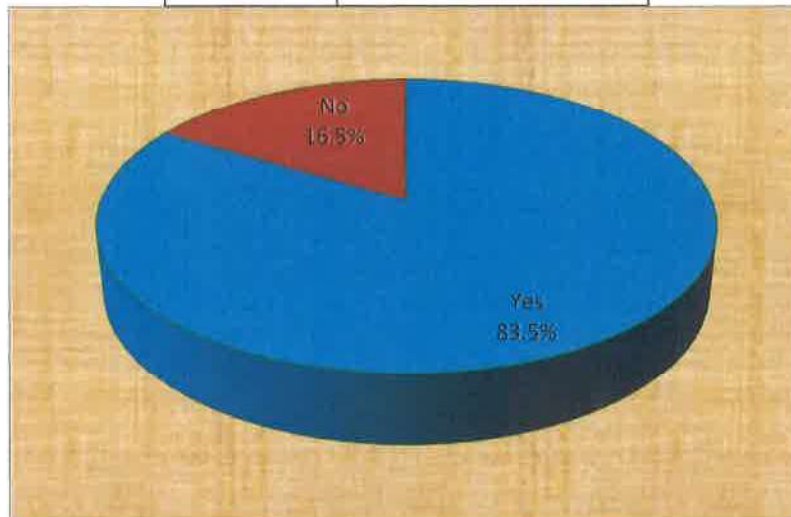
Q.6. Do you think newly introduced 50-50 pattern is useful?

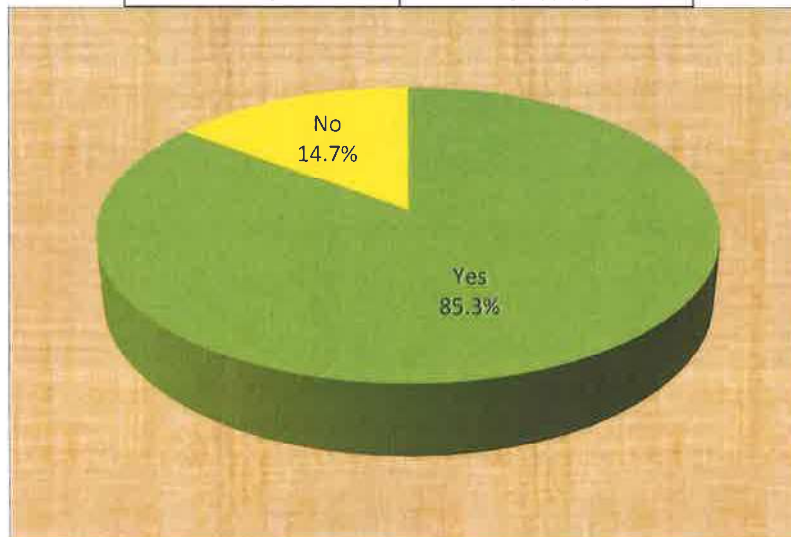
Q.7 Are you satisfied with the marks that you obtain in examinations?

With reference to the cited subject, I would like to bring to your notice that Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Deogiri College has conducted a survey on Evaluation process.

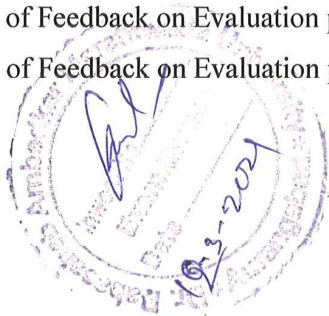
A few notable points revealed during the analysis are summarized below:

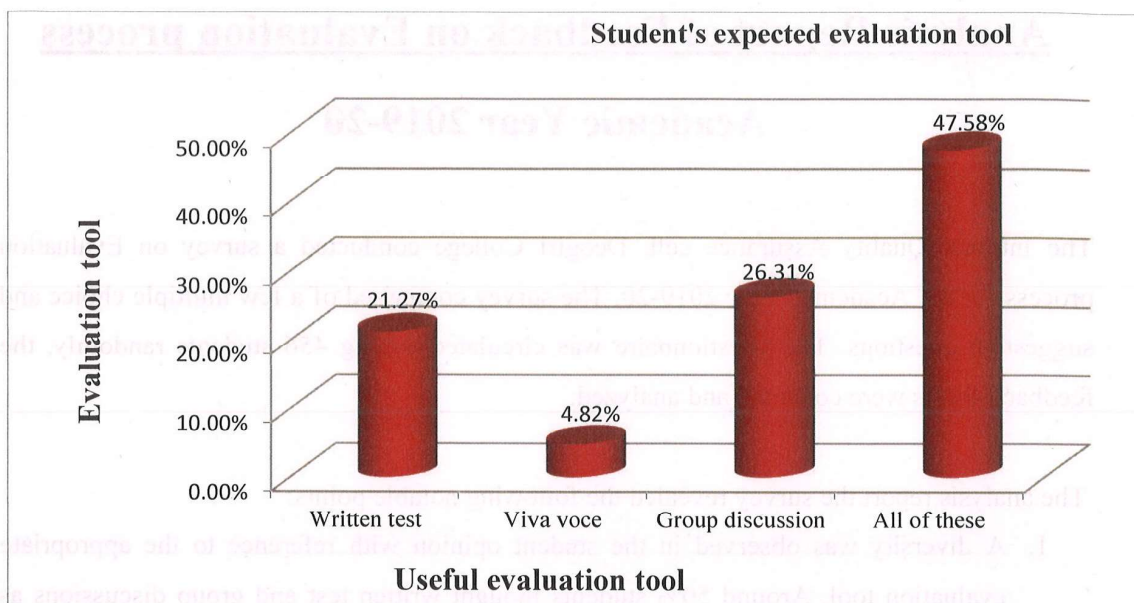
The Internal Quality Assurance cell, Deogiri College conducted a survey on Evaluation process for the Academic Year 2019-20. The survey comprised of a few multiple choice and suggestive questions. The questionnaire was circulated among 456 students randomly, the feedback forms were collected and analyzed.

The analysis report the survey revealed the following notable points:

1. A diversity was observed in the student opinion with reference to the appropriate evaluation tool. Around 50% students thought written test and group discussions as the appropriate tool for student evaluation. Around 45% of them agree with the use of all the three methods of evaluation – written test, group discussion and viva voce.
2. Approximately 80% of the respondents agree with the current performance evaluation by the university and college.
3. Around 85% of the students agree with the use of 50:50 pattern of evaluation.
4. Approximately 75% respondents were observed to be satisfied with the current redressal mechanism.

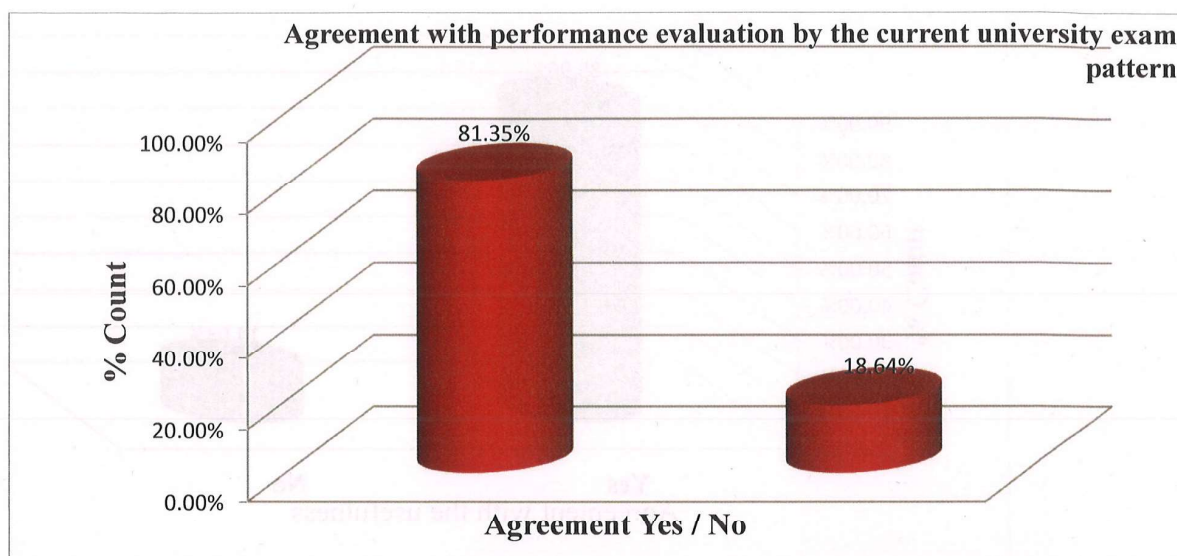

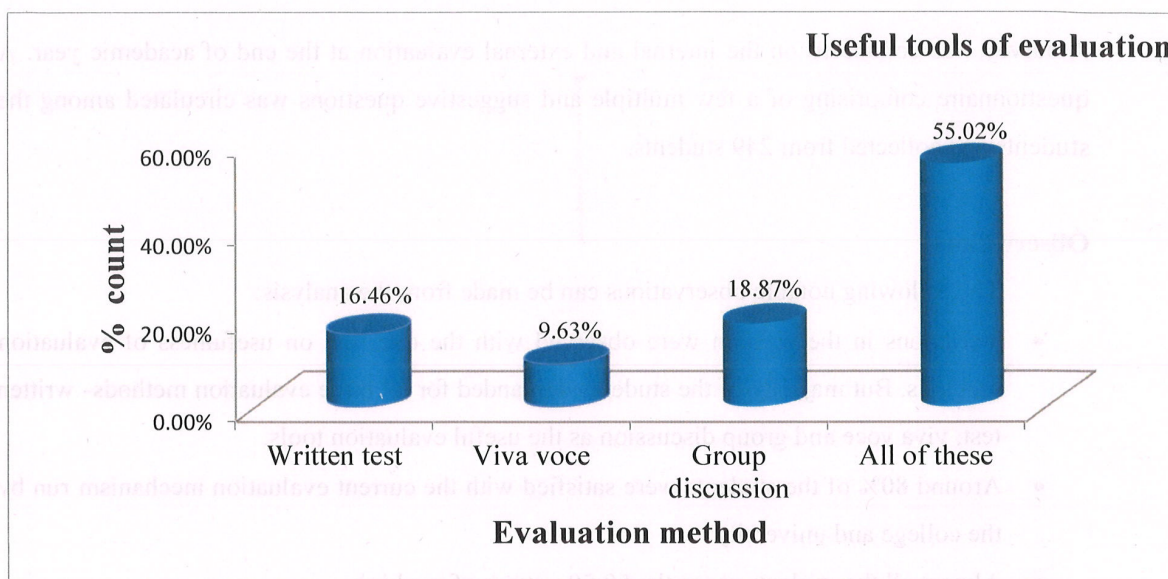
Observations:

The following notable observations can be made from the analysis:

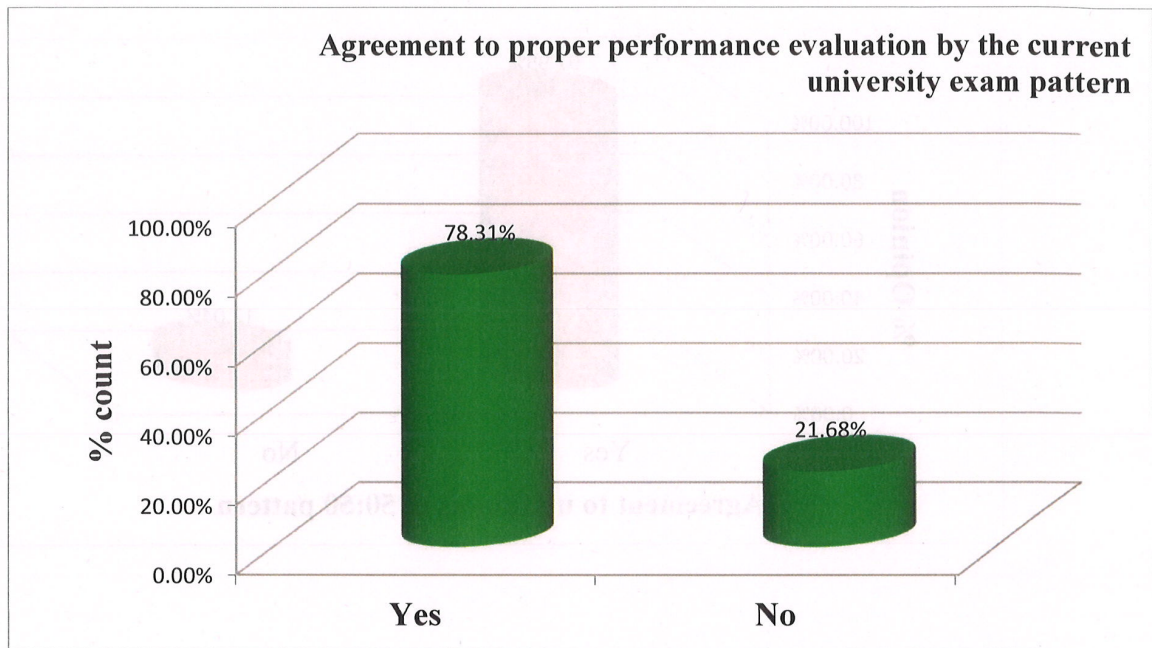




Suggestions received: The following suggestions were received from the students:

Introduction:

Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Deogiri College, Aurangabad organized **ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON TEACHING, LEARNING AND EVALUATION: ADDRESSING THE QUALITATIVE METRICS** under UGC's PARAMARSH Scheme on 5th Feb, 2021 online.

The workshop was organised for a systematic discussions and demonstrations on teaching, learning and evaluation process at the institution.

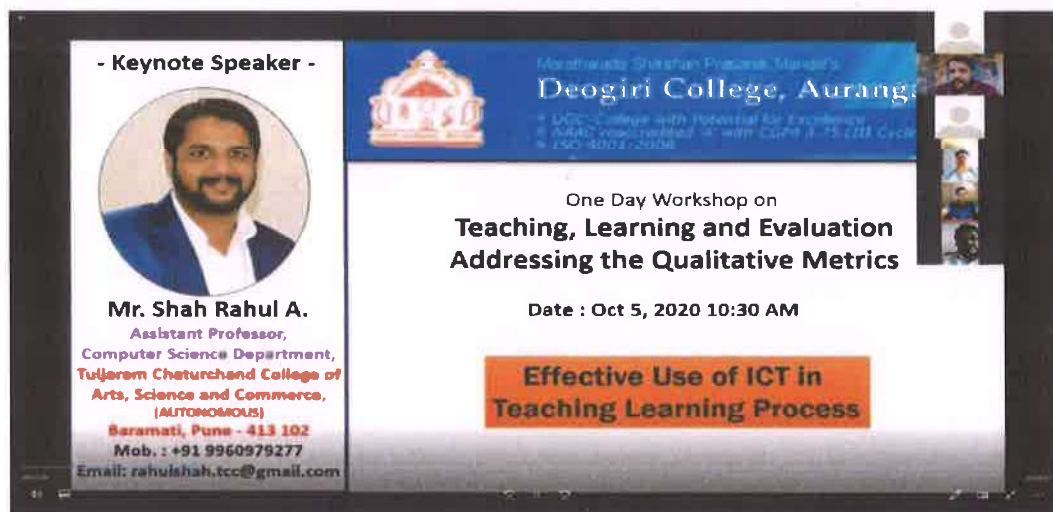

SERVQUAL Model: 5 gaps

1. Knowledge gap, 2. Standards gap, 3. Delivery gap, 4. Communications gap, 5. Satisfaction gap
2. **Gap between expectations of client and perception of management.** (in order to be able to assess customer expectations, it is of the top to provide customer satisfaction survey, measure management has to have a clear and precise knowledge about customer expectations. A lack of such knowledge creates a gap that can be one of the reasons for service measures not being suitable)
3. **Gap between perception of management and service quality specifications.** (even if management accurately perceives customer expectations, there are still chances of customer dissatisfaction that can be caused by the gap between quality of the service according to customer expectations)
4. **Gap between specification of quality and the delivery of service.** (service providers are not customer expectation results to the failure of effectively specified quality service and to various reasons including resources available and sufficient service processes)
5. **The gap between the delivery of service and actual communication.** (in some service provider company employees may receive orders and instructions to take delivery standard quality service, all customer may be not motivated due to undermotivation)
6. **Gap between perceived and expected service.** (even, one of the customer expects the service and along the time they have received)

We can understand these gaps through such surveys which helps to improve the quality of related services


