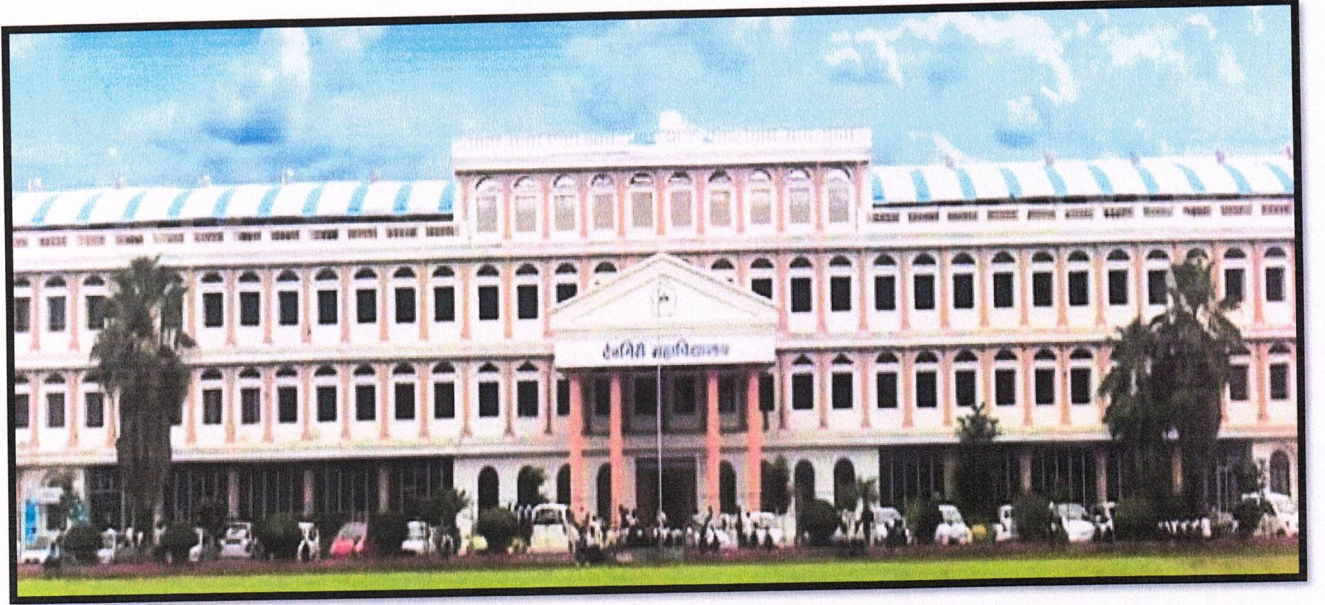

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**Report of the Activities under
UGC's Scheme PARAMARSH**

Introduction:

Deogiri College, Aurangabad was selected as a mentor institution under UGC's scheme of PARAMARSH launched for mentoring non-accredited institutions in the region.

The scheme was sanctioned to the college in Sept, 2019 and its period was extended eventually taking into considerations the Covid-19 pandemic conditions till Sept, 2021.


In the beginning following five institutions were involved with us under the scheme:

1. Chhatrapati Shahu Arts, Commerce and Science College, Lasur Station, Dist. Aurangabad
2. Shivchhatrapati Arts College, Pachod, Dist. Aurangabad
3. Chetna Sanstha's Arts College, Savangi, Dist. Aurangabad
4. Deogiri Institute of Technology and Management Studies, Aurangabad
5. Rajashri Shahu Arts and Science College, Lanzi, Dist. Aurangabad

However, office of Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyaan of Maharashtra made inclusion of two institutions under the scheme to mentored by Deogiri College, Aurangabad. The following are the institutions:

1. Ekta Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's College of Arts, Bidkin, Dist. Aurangabad
2. Government Institute of Forensic Science, Aurangabad, Dist. Aurangabad

Due to the pandemic, the institutions faced several challenges in their preparation for the accreditation. However, after a series of online and offline workshops with the mentee institutions, the institutions are in their final stages in preparations towards the accreditation by NAAC.

DETAILS OF THE PROGRAMS ORGANIZED UNDER THE SCHEME

2019-2020 and 2020-2021

There were primarily meetings with stakeholders of the institutions like:


1. Principals
2. IQAC Coordinators
3. Members of the Management
4. Staff


After physical meetings with the stakeholders, a pool of resource persons was formulated to mentor the institutions towards the accreditation process by NAAC.

During the pandemic, workshops and webinars were organized on ZOOM platform accommodating participants from all the mentee institutions.

Following are the features of online and offline activities organized for the mentee institutions:

1. Criterion wise discussion were conducted online
2. Webinars were organized on each criterion inviting experts from different parts of the state
3. There were collaborative activities with the mentor institution
4. During offline workshop, experts engaged themselves in discussion with the teams at the mentee institution.
5. There were hands on training at Deogiri College, Aurangabad organized for writing of qualitative metrics and provision of supporting documents for quantitative metrics.
6. Issues like gender audit, mentoring, etc were also addressed
7. On the Whatsapp group formed for the stakeholders of the mentee institutions also proved to be a very helpful platform for exchange of ideas.

MAJOR HIGHLIGHTS/ACHIEVEMENTS:


The following are the salient achievements and outcomes:

Besides these programmes, IQAC of Deogiri College, Aurangabad organized visits to mentee institutions to orient the staff for assessment and accreditation.

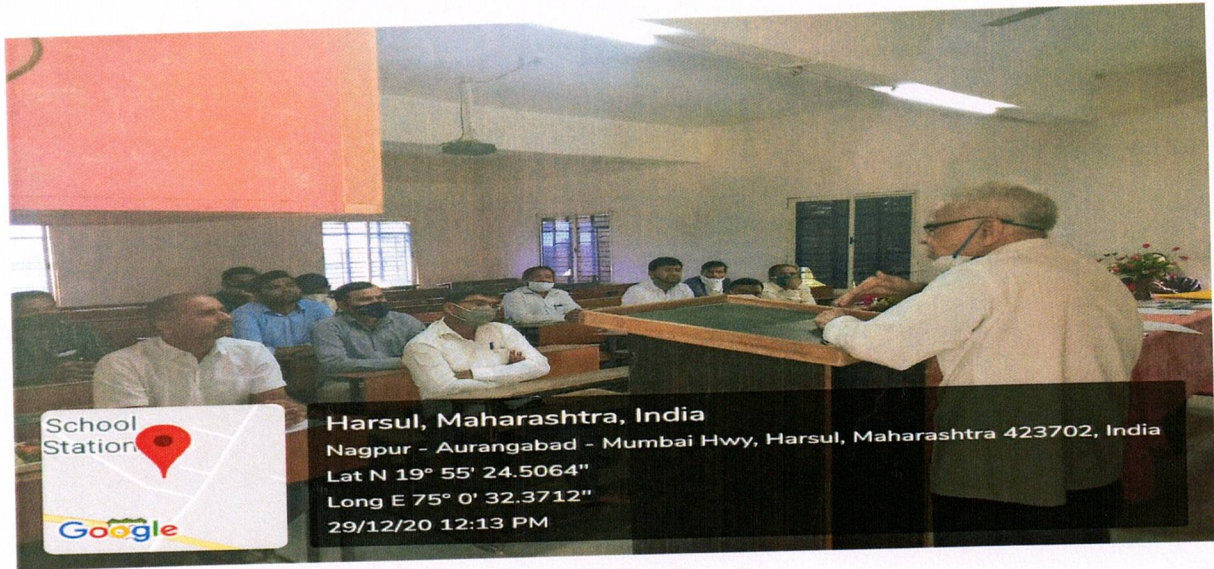

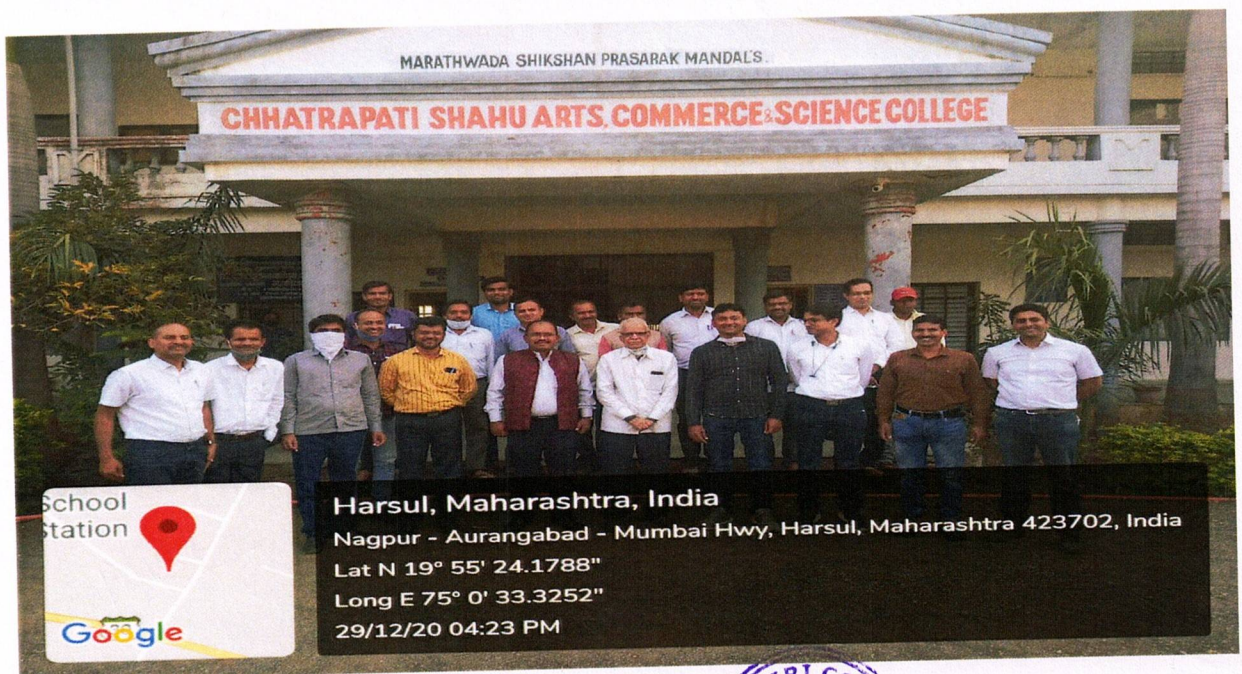

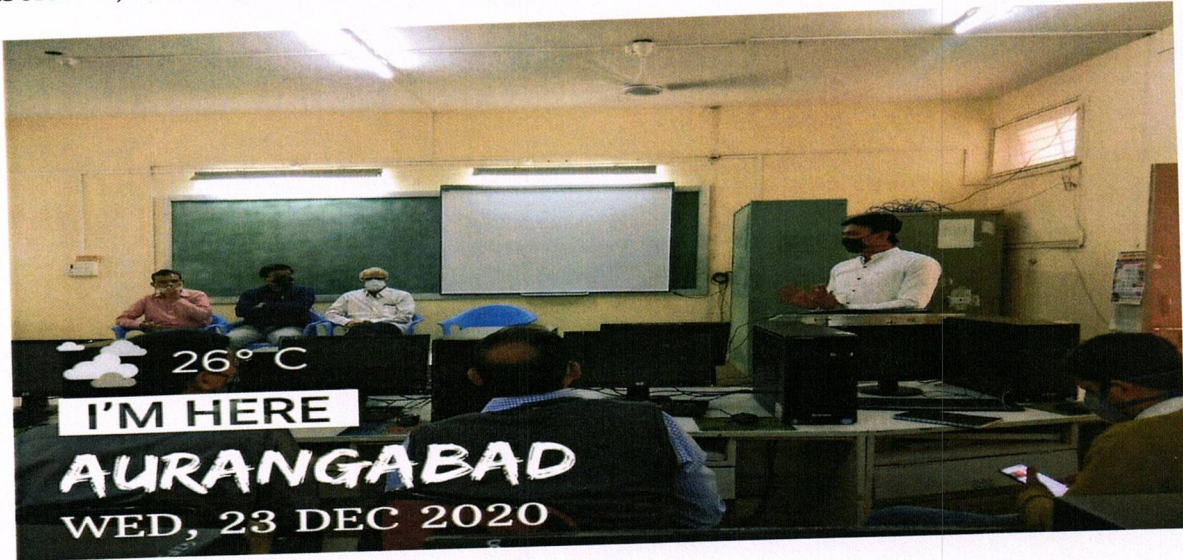

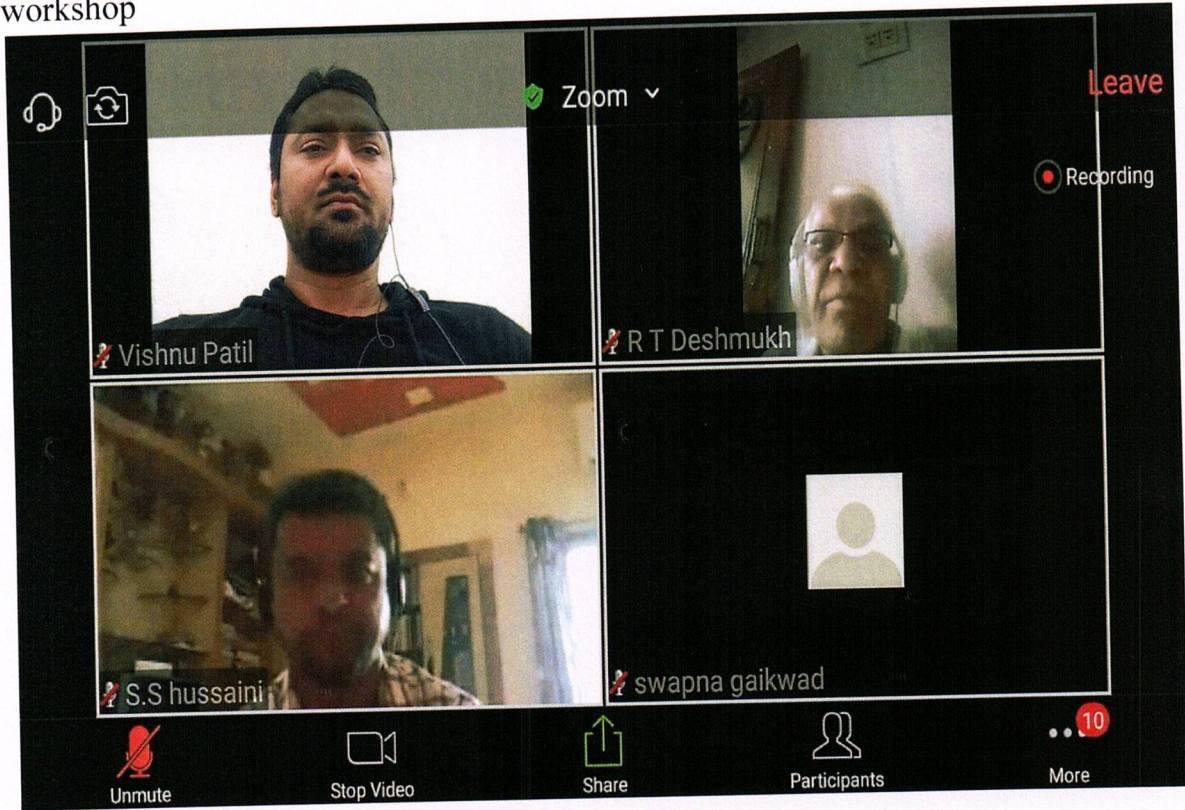

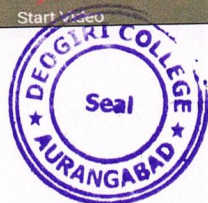
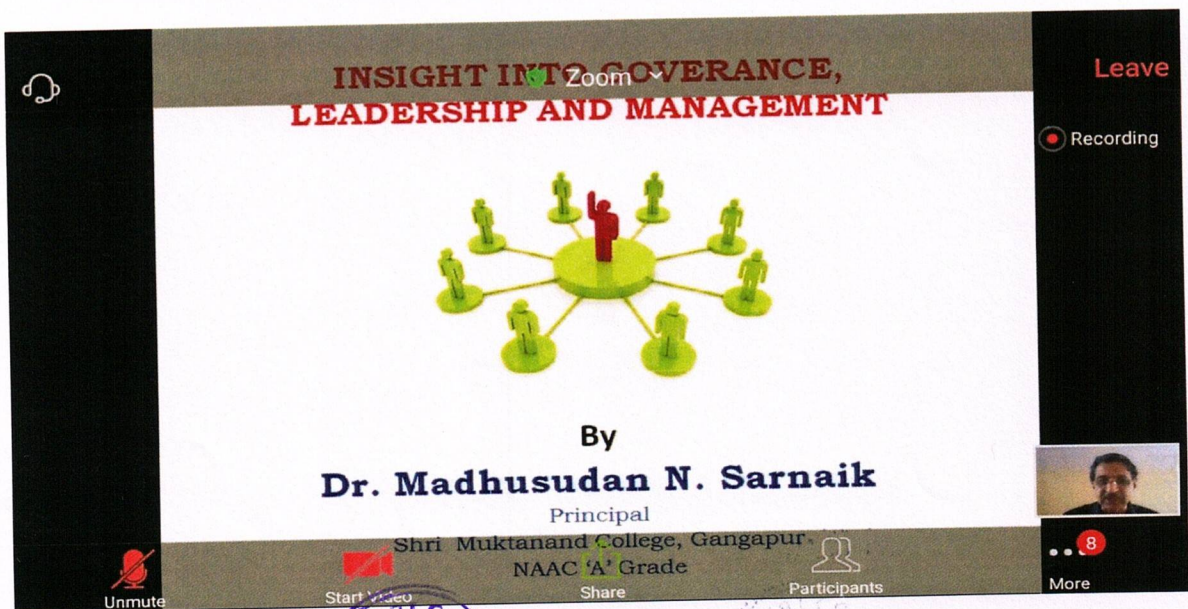

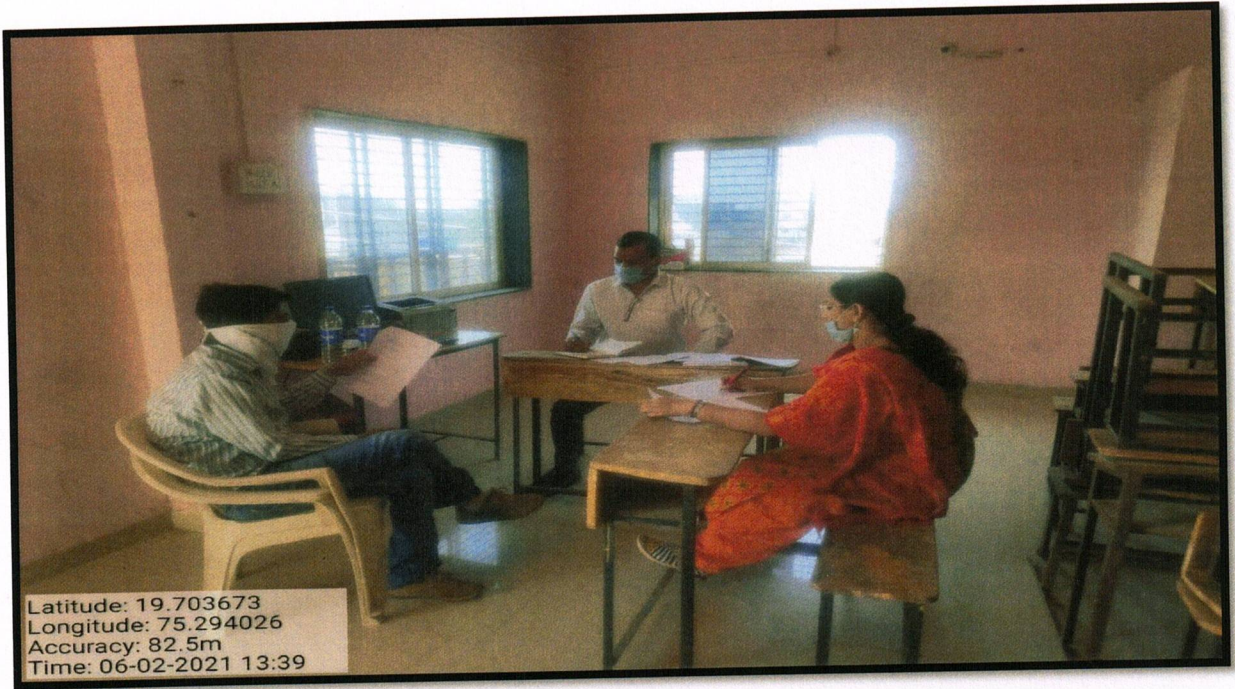
