demonstration about evaluation and assessment process while using inline platforms for teaching and learning process.

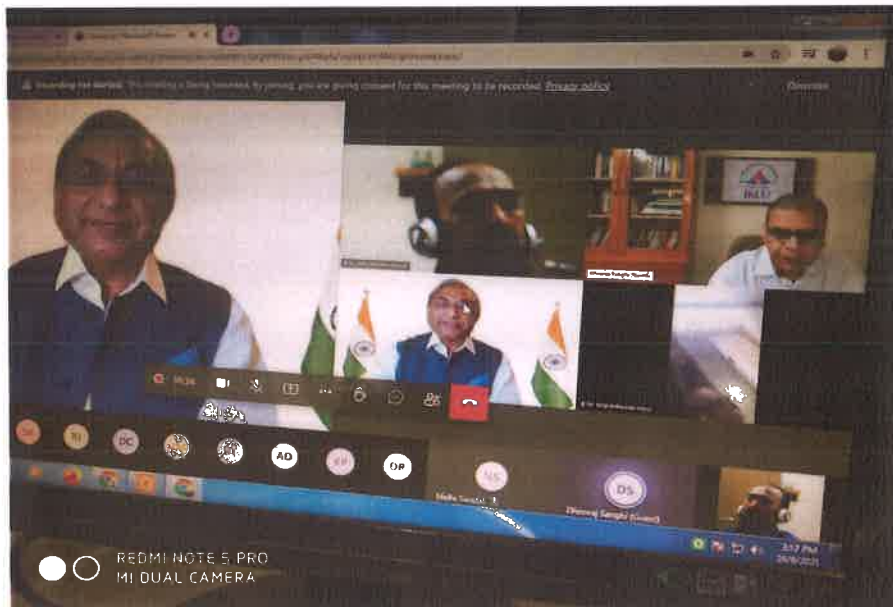

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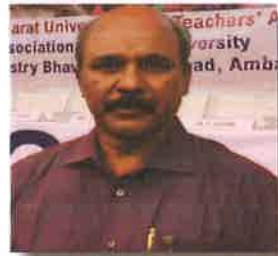

4. The recommendations/suggestions/action points (Outcome of the Seminar)

The seminar and its theme proved a very helpful idea and tool to several teachers participating in the event. The teachers always wanted to have a clear idea about the topic selection for constructing online course modules, its launch, its video preparation, etc. Following are few of the recommendations made after the details discussions followed by each session.

- a. Each college to set a media centre where teachers can get technical assistance in order to prepare the modules and videos.
 - b. There is need to sensitize college people about UGC's scheme about such content development and financial support.
 - c. If not our own online course modules, the learners at the colleges can be encouraged to go for online course available on the platforms like SWAYAM, NPTEL, UGC, AICT, etc.
 - d. There is a need to organize special training sessions on preparation of such modules and videos.
 - e. The scheme by UGC I to be made more teacher-friendly in which teachers from colleges should not face more difficulty.
 - f. A course could be offered on how to prepare such modules on platforms like SWAYAM
5. Follow up actions, the institution proposes to undertake:
The college intends to take two level follow up action plan i.e. institution level and policy level.

Summary:

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Deogiri College, Aurangabad organized NAAC sponsored one day national seminar on 'Use of Technology and E-Content in Teaching and Learning' on 23rd Sept, 2019.

Details of the participants:

Total 94 participants participated in the seminar out of which 12 hailed from out of the state. There were active demonstrations sessions during the seminar. And total 49 research papers were received for the publication as a special issue of Chronicle of Humanities and Cultural Studies, a peer reviewed bimonthly international journal. However, there were only resource person talks and no session of paper presentation was arranged due to time constraints.

Details of Resource Persons and their Topics:

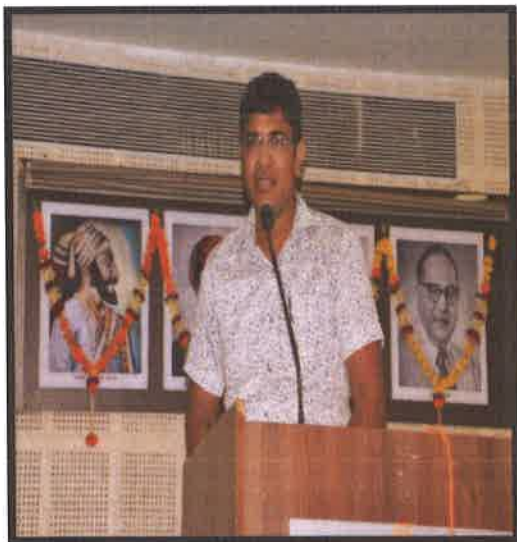

interactive session was more valuable towards revised accreditation framework of NAAC.



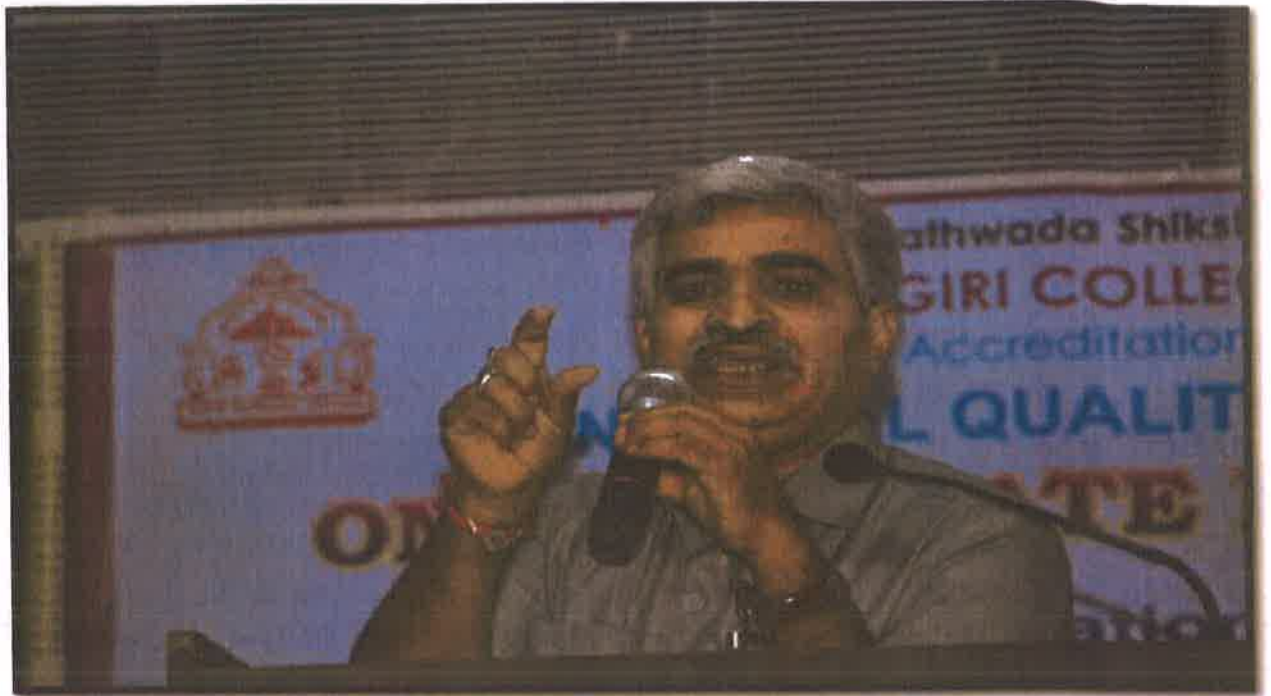

Gist of Resource Persons' talk

1. Dr. Sharad Mohite

Dr. Mohite highlighted that in recent times there is a shift in the orientation of not only students but also the parents in view of education and the courses offered in the higher educational institutes. He said that perhaps the biggest trend is to choose which course to learn for the students. India has long been described as an economy in which graduates concentrate on becoming doctors, lawyers, accountants, and engineers and even though it is still valid largely, the variety of programs, as they offered it, has opened up the market for other avenues. There are YouTubers and social media influencers whose success has opened up a different set of opportunities itself, which were earlier not imagined. Today, students are looking to explore further skills and vocational courses in areas such as Video Editing, Design thinking, Fashion, Marketing, PR, Communications, and other niche fields such as e-commerce, Hospitality, Food & Catering, Data Science, Machine Learning, Artificial Intelligence, even specialisation in Edu-Tech programs. He added that transition to digitalization in teaching and learning encourages concept-based learning that helps students to develop key skills and be prepared for careers in the future. He concluded saying that as a matter of fact, being teachers, it is our responsibility to keep a bird's eye on changing facets in modern times as far as teaching and research is concerned. The session was anchored by Dr. Sanjay Ratnaparkhe where as Mr. Ajit Dhas proposed vote of thanks.

2. Dr. Navin Patil

During session II, Dr. Navin Patil spoke about recent practices in research. He said that multi and transdisciplinary research has been proved as a dominant research practice now a days. Trans-disciplinarity connotes a research strategy that crosses many disciplinary boundaries to create a holistic approach. It applies to research efforts focused on problems that cross the boundaries of two or more disciplines, such as research on effective information systems for biomedical research and can refer to concepts or methods that were originally developed by one discipline, but are now used by several others, such as ethnography, a field research method originally developed in anthropology but now widely used by other disciplines. It is also a fact that a transdisciplinary approach is enabling inputs and scoping across scientific and non-scientific stakeholder communities and facilitating a systemic way of addressing a challenge.

Dr. Vijay Shinde anchored this session and Mr. Satish Deshmukh proposed vote of thanks. The program concluded by the remarks made by Principal Dr. S. N. Thore who highlighted on the role and responsibility of a teacher in the prevailing academic

scenario and added that a teacher must update and upgrade himself for effectiveness in the process of teaching-learning. 168 teachers participated in this academic faculty development program.
