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III. Review of Existing Courses/programmes, Restructuring, and Redesigning.

VII. Methods of Evaluation, Conduct of Examinations, and Notification of the Results:

1. As per the decision of the Academic Council, all the academic programmes have 40:60 pattern i. e. 40% marks for Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) and 60% marks for End Semester Examination (ESE).
2. The CIE pattern includes internal tests, tutorials, assignments, MCQ tests etc.
3. The results of all the academic programmes declared in the stipulated timeframe i.e. within 20 days of end of end semester examination.
4. College registered on NAD portal to upload the APAAR (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry) Ids.
5. Data uploading of around 3200 students is in progress (last date of submission is 30th Nov. 2025).



XV. Observations of External Peer Team


