



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ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A) Admission:

- 1. Students should have prescribed original documents with 3 photo copies at the time of admission as per list.
- 2. All admissions are computerized, permanent registration number (PRN) will be assigned to each student.
- 3. Necessary documents like eligibility certificate, migration certificate, E.B.C., scholarship and freeship forms must be submitted within stipulated time.
- 4. For confirm admission, student have to pay prescribed fees.
- 5. All admissions are provisional. Principal reserves the rights of final admission and may cancel any admission after verification of documents.
- 6. Students must preserve all original fee receipts without which no refund will be entertained.
- 7. Soon after admission, Identity Card should be obtained otherwise Rs. 100/- will be charged for delayed collection & for duplicate I-card.
- 8. All UG and PG admissions are as per University rules and guidelines.
- 9. All UG & PG admissions are through ONLINE process. Visit <u>www.deogiricollege.org</u>

B) Rules for Refund offees:

I. For Granted Courses:

1. Cancellation of admission on or before September 30, 2025, total paid fees will be refunded as special case.

- 2. Cancellation of admission on or before October 31, 2025, paid fees will be refunded by deducting Rs.1000/- as a processing fee.
- 3. Cancellation of admission after October 31, 2025, there will be no refund and required to pay full fees as prescribed.

4. On cancellation of admission fee refund rules may changed as per University and Govt. guidelines.

II. For Non-Granted Courses:

- 1. Cancellation of admission before September 30, 2025, total paid fees will be refunded as special case.
- 2. Cancellation of admission on or before October 31, 2025, paid fees will be refunded by deducting Rs.1000/-as a processing fee.
- 3 Cancellation of admission after October 31, 2025, there will be no refund and required to pay full fees as prescribed.
- 4. On cancellation of admission fee refund rules may changed as per University and Govt. guidelines.

C) Attendance:

- 1. 75% attendance for theory classes and practicals is Compulsory.
- 2. Irregular students are liable for strict disciplinary action.
- 3. Attendance for college tests, tutorials and terminal examinations is compulsory.
- 4. Performance of students throughout the year will be monitored and will be reported to parents.
- 5. Use of unfair means in the college as well as in university examinations is strictly prohibited.

D) Library:

- 1. For all library transactions Identity Card is compulsory.
- 2. The library is well equipped with large number of textbooks reference books, highest number of national & International Journals & Periodicals e-books, e-Journals & CD's, Photocopying facility internet facility, Independent reading Hall for Girls. Braille Machine & NVDA/LOW Vision software for Visually impaired student.
- 3. Students shall collect library cards by producing Identity Card. The library card duly filled and with one photograph is to be submitted at the issue counter for borrowing books.
- 4. If library card is lost, student has to inform the librarian in writing and he/she will have to pay Rs. 50/- for the duplicate card.
- 5. Library books must be returned within seven days from date of issue.
- 6. If a student fails to return the book before due date, he/she will be charged late fees. (1 rupee per day per book)
- 7. Students must check the books thoroughly in respect of any damage or missing pages while borrowing itself. Later on, no complaints in this respect will be considered and he/she will have to pay fine according to the rules.
- 8. If Identity card is lost, student has to inform the librarian in writing and he/she will have to pay Rs. 100/- for the duplicate Identity card.

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E) Campus beautification and responsibility :

- 1. To keep the campus clean, green and beautiful.
- 2. Writing on furniture, wall sand toilet blocks is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Pasting and bills, posters and distribution of such material among students is not allowed without prior permission.
- 4. The college property such as furniture, library books, laboratory equipments, sports equipments shoud be used with extreme care without causing any damage
- 5. Vehicles must be parked at the places fixed for parking.
- 6. Driving on the playground or other restricted areas is strictly prohibited.
- 7. Dustbins are to be used for waste material.

F) Code of Conduct for Students:

1. General Discipline

- Students are expected to maintain discipline at all times in college premises.
- The use of cellular / mobile phones, pagers and other wireless equipments is prohibited in the working areas of the Institute (classrooms, corridors, library, lab). Violation of this rule may lead to confiscation of the instrument by the authorities.
 - Students are also expected to have good conduct with propriety in the hostel and outside the campus. Students who get involved inpublic disturbances will face suspension or possible expulsion from the Institute.

2. Dress code :

• Students are always expected to be in college uniform while they are in campus.

3. Punctuality :

• Students are expected to be punctual for their classes, as well as for seminars, presentations, and assessment tests.

4. Evaluation Process :

• Any use of unfair means in any component of evaluation in the Programme is viewed seriously by the Institute. The student is expected to keep herself/himself well informed about the latest examination regulations. The regulations will be informed to the students in advance and will also be available at respective department.

5. General:

- Students are expected to make proper use of all the amenities provided on campus including the library, lab and the common room facilities. Disciplinary action will be taken against students who misuse these facilities. Students are required not to litter classrooms and otherworking areas of the Institute.
- OHPs and other audio-visual equipment used in class should be handled with care.

6. Disciplinary Action:

- All cases of individual misconduct/indiscipline will be investigated by the Disciplinary Committee duly constituted by the Principal. This committee will hear the students' viewpoint before making its recommendations to the Principal in each individual case. The decision of the Principal shall be final and binding.
- Disciplinary action for misconduct will include the imposition of fine, exclusion from the award of trophies/ prizes, withholding of placement opportunities on campus, debarring from appearing for the final examinations, and inserious cases, suspension / expulsion from the programme.
 - The Institute reserves the right to ask a student to leave the programme at any time during the academic year, if the student's academic performance and general conduct as judged by the Institute be found unsatisfactory.

G) Punitive Action as per Statute of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016.

- 1. Imposition of fine up to Rs. 300/- or more.
- 2. Debarring from attending the classes for specified period.
- 3. Disqualifying from participating in any co-curricular or cultural activities of the College.
- 4. Withholding of any college document.
- 5. Denial of admission to a course or to college/ university or board examination.
- 6. Cancellation of admission to the college at any stage.
- 7. Withholding of examination results.

H) Scholarship:

- 1. All scholarships from the central and the state government are made available to eligible students.
- 2. After admission, students should submit duly filled form with necessary documents.
- 3. Eligible students for scholarship will have to open a bank account.
- 4. Students, whose scholarship is not sanctioned, will have to pay full fees.
- 5. Late submission of scholarship forms or incomplete forms may be rejected.



I) Hostel Accommodation:

- 1. For admission to boys and girls hostels, students have to fill up a separate application form.
- 2. If selected for admission to hostel, students will have to pay the requisite fees in time.
- 3. Students cannot leave the hostel without warden's prior permission.
- 4. Friends and relatives are not permitted to enter the hostel rooms.
- 5. No outside meals are allowed.
- 6. All other hostel rules must be followed.

J) N.C.C. And N.S.S.

- 1. For admission to N.C.C. and N.S.S. separate application forms are required to be submitted.
- 2. Student must attend regular activities, parades, annual camps.
- 3. The detailed information about these services can be collected from the N.S.S, N.C.C. units.

Rules and Regulations pertaining to scholarship

Rules and Regulations for Government of India Scholarship / Freeship for students belonging to backward classes viz. Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribes / De-Notified Tribes / Nomadic Tribes, Specical Backward Class

& Other Backward Class & others will be as per Government norms.

Essential Documents :-

- 1. S.D.O. caste certificate, last year's Marks Memo, Transfer Certificate, S.S.C. Class Memo, all attested zerox copies.
- 2. Original income certificate (Tehsildar) limit of annual income for S.C. & S.T. students is 2,00,000 (Two Lakh). For VJNT, O.B.C., and S.B.C., 1,00,000 (One Lakh). If the annual income is more than the limit amount, such students are not eligible to fill scholarship form. They can fill freeship form.
- 3. In case of father's death, attach zerox copy of the Death Certificate and Income Certificate in favour of mother's name.
 - 4. Attach Gap Certificate if there is any gap in education. (It must be on bond paper from competent authority.)
 - 5. One latest passport size photograph.
 - 6. Photocopy of AadharCard.
 - 7. Personal Bank Account in any nationalized bank is required. (Pass Book zerox copy)
 - 8. If students are admitted from other college of district, they must attach G.O.I. Sanctioned No. Certificate and certificate of district change.
 - 9. After filling online form www.mahadbtmahait.gov.inform, hard copy must be submitted at G.O.I.Scholarship counter with the above said documents.
 - 10. If the student has passed any professional course, he/she is not eligible to fill G.O.I Scholarship form. They can fill freeship form. i.e. if he/she passes degree course and joins B.Ed, and again seeks addmission to P.G. course, will not be eligible.
 - 11. This concession is applicable only to the students of right conduct and whose attendance is more than 75% with satisfactory academic progress.
 - 12. Duplicate T.C. holders are not eligible to fill the scholarship forms.
 - 13. Students will have to pay full fees for enclosing duplicate T.C., and such students cannot avail the benifits of G.O.I scholarship.
 - 14. If Scholarship or freeship is rejected due to some reason, students will have to pay full fees.
 - 15. Students are soley responsible for submission & sanction of scholarship, failure to which students shall be treated full payee.
 - 16. Scholarship will be distributed to scholarship holders as and when amount is received from Government.
 - 17. Rules & Regulations pertaining to Schlorship may be changed as per Govt. orders.


