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## Respondents Details:

### 1. Fulfillment of My (students) Learning Needs:

From the total 221 student respondents, maximum (194) respondents rated as excellent in respect of fulfillment of their learning needs by curriculum, followed by 18 respondents, rated it as good, 7 respondents replied as average in this respect whereas 2 respondents said it is below average.

### 2. Application of the Curriculum to the Real Life Situation:

It is found that the maximum (198) of student's respondent opined that the applicability of the curriculum to the real life situation found excellent, 12 think as good, 9 replied as it is average and two said it is below average.

### 3. Clarity about the Course Objectives:

The highest (198) respondents from the total students noted that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found excellent; followed by 14 remarked as good, 9 thinks it is average and 1 replied as below average.

### 4. Weightage Given to Employability:

From the total 292 respondents, majority (199) of student respondents opined that the Weightage given to employability in curriculum found excellent, 13 opined it is good, 8 rated it is average and 1 said below average in this respect.

### 5. Weightage Given to Skill Development:


It is found that the highest (193) number of respondents opined that the Weightage given to skill development in curriculum is found excellent. 20 thinks in this case as good, 7 opined as average and 1 think it is below average.

From the total 221 respondents, the maximum number of respondents 194 respondents rated as the difficulty level in the course contents in curriculum taught is found excellent, followed by 20 respondents rated to difficulty level of curriculum is as good, 06 respondents said it is average and 1

## Respondents Details:

### 1. Applicability of the syllabus to Local Developmental Needs:

The 122 teacher respondents had given their responses on applicability of the syllabus to local developmental needs. It is found that majority 61) respondents rated as good, followed by 53 respondents replied as it is excellent and 8 respondents said average in this case.

### 2. Difficulty Level of the Syllabus:

Out of 119, it is found that the 74 of teacher respondents opined that the difficulty level of the syllabus in curriculum is found good, 29 think it is excellent and 13 replied as it is average and 3 respondents said that it is below average.

### 3. Clarity about the Course Objectives:

From the 114 teacher respondents. The highest 62 respondents from the total teacher think that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found good; followed by 43 remarked as excellent, 8 opined it is as average and 1 said below average.

### 4. Weightage given to Employability:

The fourth aspect of this survey concerned with Weightage given to employability in curriculum. From the total 115 teacher respondents, majority teachers (65) said that the Weightage given to employability in curriculum found good, 38 observed it is excellent, 11 rated it as average and only 1 respondent said it is found below average.

### 5. Depth of the Course Content:


As far as depth of the course contents is concerned maximum (64) number of respondents opined that they found it good, followed by 37 think it is as excellent, 8 remarked it is as average.

### 6. Incorporation of the Latest Knowledge & Information:

The six aspect of the feedback is concerned with incorporation of the latest knowledge & information. It is observed that the maximum 70 teachers said that the incorporation of the latest knowledge & information in curriculum found good, 48 said it is excellent, 13 rated as it is average.

### 7. Research Possibilities:

From the total 112 teacher respondents, the maximum 62 respondents found research possibilities in curriculum found good, followed by 41 and 13 replied as excellent and average respectively in this respect..
