Respondents Details:

1. Fulfillment of My (students) Learning Needs:

From the total 484 student respondents, maximum (254) respondents rated as good in respect of fulfillment of their learning needs by curriculum, followed by 143 respondents, rated it as excellent, 63 respondents replied as average in this respect whereas 24 respondents said it is below average.

2. Application of the Curriculum to the Real Life Situation:

It is found that the maximum (290) of student's respondent opined that the applicability of the curriculum to the real life situation found good, 92 think as excellent, 86 replied as it is average and 16 said it is satisfactory.

3. Clarity about the Course Objectives:

The highest (244) respondents from the total students noted that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found good; followed by 121 remarked as excellent, 88 thinks it is average and 3 replied as satisfactory.

4. Weightage Given to Employability:

From the total 484 respondents, majority (183) of student respondents opined that the Weightage given to employability in curriculum found best, 160 opined it is good, 81 rated it is excellent and 60 said satisfactory in this respect.

5. Weightage Given to Skill Development:

It is found that the highest (250) number of respondents opined that the Weightage given to skill development in curriculum is found good. 112 thinks in this case as excellent, 90 opined as average and 32 think it is satisfactory.

6. Weightage Given to Entrepreneurship:

The six aspect of the feedback is concerned with Weightage given to entrepreneurship. The collected information indicate that the maximum number of respondents (253) found the Weightage given to entrepreneurship in curriculum is good, followed by 131said it is excellent 76, 6 opined as it is average and 24 said satisfactory.

7. Difficulty Level of the Course Contents:

From the total 484 respondents, the maximum number of respondents 241 respondents rated as the difficulty level in the course contents in curriculum taught is found good, followed by 130 respondents rated to difficulty level of course content in curriculum is as average, 88 respondents said it is excellent and 25 rated as satisfactory.



8. Promotion of independent Thinking by Curriculum:

It is observed that majority (278) of the students feel that promotion of independent thinking through curriculum taught is good, followed by 105 of them opined as excellent, 76 observed it is average and 225 said it is satisfactory.

9. Usefulness of the curriculum at workplace:

From the total 484 student's respondents, highest (236) of the respondents opined that the Usefulness of the curriculum at workplace taught found good. 132 think as excellent, 92 observed it is as average and 24 said satisfactory.
